

Snow Day Cardigan

## SIZES

XS (S, M, L, XL) (2X, 3X, 4X, 5X)
Shown in size M

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: $381 / 2(421 / 2,461 / 2,501 / 2,541 / 2)(581 / 2,621 / 2$, 6612, 70122)"
Length: 28 (28, 29½, 2912, 311/4) (311⁄4, 323/4, $323 / 4,331 / 2)^{\prime \prime}$

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Snow Cone ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Light Chenille (100\% Polyester; 7oz/200g, 188yds/172m)

- 2013-12 Strawberry - $4(4,5,5,6)(6$, 7, 7, 8) balls
Hook: US Size L-11 ( 8 mm ) or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, 4 locking stitch markers


## GAUGE

10 hdc $\times 6$ rows $=4^{\prime \prime}$
11 sc $\times 10$ rows $=4$ "
Save time, check your gauge.

## Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, half double crochet and single crochet stitches.
- Creating a side seam pocket.
- Foundation half double crochet and foundation single crochet stitches.
- Seaming panels together.
- Working in the back loops of stitches.
- Working a Collar directly onto edges of Fronts.


## STITCH GUIDE

Fhdc (foundation half double crochet): Ch 2,
yo and insert hook in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook, yo, pull up loop (3 loops on hook), yo, pull through 1 loop (1 ch made), yo, pull through all 3 loops on hook ( 1 fhdc made), *yo and insert hook under the 2 loops of the ch at base of last st, pull up loop, yo, pull through 1 loop, yo, pull through all 3 loops on hook; rep from * to desired number of fhdc.

Fsc (foundation single crochet): *Insert hook under the 2 loops of the ch at base of last st, pull up loop, yo, pull through 1 loop, yo, pull through 2 loops on hook; rep from * to desired number of fsc.

## PATTERN NOTES

This Cardigan is worked in pieces and seamed. Each piece is worked from side to side, working the Bottom Border/Cuff at the same time. A side seam pocket is stitched onto the wrong sides of Fronts before seaming panels together. Make the Pocket Liners first and use as a gauge swatch.

## CARDIGAN

Pocket Liner (make 2)
Row 1: Fhdc 15.
Rows 2-9: Ch 2 (does not count as a st throughout), hdc in each st across, turn - 15 hdc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for seaming. Set aside.

Back
Row 1: Fhdc $64(66,66,66,68)(68,72,72,74)$, pm in last st made to mark Borders sts, starting under the 2 loops at the base of the last fhdc made, fsc 10 for Border, turn - 74 (76, 76, 76, $78)(78,82,82,84)$ sts.

Row 2: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), working in back loops only, sc in each of next 10 sts, hdc in next st, pm, hdc in each rem st across, turn Move the marker up with each row to delineate Border sts.
Row 3: Ch 2, hdc across to marked st, working in back loops only, sc in each of rem 10 Border sts, turn.
Next Rows: Rep Rows 2-3 until piece measures 1914 ( $211 \frac{1}{4}, 231 / 4,251 / 4,271 / 4$ ) ( $291 / 4,311 / 4,331 / 4,351 / 4$ )" from foundation row, fasten off.

Front (make 2)
Row 1: Fhdc $64(66,66,66,68)(68,72,72,74)$, pm in last st made to mark Borders sts, starting under the 2 loops at the base of the last fhdc made, fsc 10 for Border, turn - $74(76,76,76,78)(78,82,82,84)$ sts.
Row 2: Ch 1, working in back loops only, sc in each of next 10 sts, hdc in next st, pm, hdc in each rem st across, turn.
Move marker up with each row to delineate Border sts.
Row 3: Ch 2, hdc across to marked st, working in back loops only, sc in each of rem 10 Border sts, turn.
Next Rows: Rep Rows 2-3 until piece measures $81 / 4$ ( 9 , $10,103 / 4,113 / 4)(121 / 2,131 / 2,14,15)^{\prime \prime}$ from foundation row, fasten off.

Sleeve (make 2)
Row 1: Fhdc $34(36,36,38,38)(38,36,36,34)$, pm in last st made to mark Cuff sts, starting under the 2 loops at the base of the last fhdc made, fsc 10 for Cuff, turn $-44(46,46,48,48)(48,46,46,44)$ sts.
Row 2: Ch 1, working in back loops only, sc in each of next 10 sts, hdc in next st, pm, hdc in each rem st
across, turn.
Move marker up with each row to delineate Cuff sts.
Row 3: Ch 2, hdc across to marked st, working in back loops only, sc in each of rem 10 Cuff sts, turn.
Next Rows: Rep Rows 2-3 until piece measures 12
$(13,14,15,16)(17,18,19,20)$ " from foundation row, fasten off.

FINISHING
Weave in ends. Block pieces to finished measurements.

Pin Pocket Liner in place $20^{\prime \prime}$ from top edge of Front so that last row of Pocket Liner lines up with side edge of Front. Rep on other Front, mirroring the placement so that next Pocket Liner lines up with opposite side edge of Front. Whipstitch pockets in place around 3 sides, leaving the side adjacent to the side edge of Front unseamed. Ensure the stitching does not show through on the other side of the Front (RS). The side where you placed The Pocket Liners is now the WS of the Front Panels.
Sew Fronts to back at shoulders using a mattress stich, place locking marker at the top center of each Sleeve Use marker to align center of Sleeve with shoulder seam. Using a mattress stitch, sew Sleeves along the edge of Front and Back.
Sew the Sleeves and then Front and Back until you reach Pocket Lined edge. Continue sewing along unseamed edge of Pocket Liner and then rem lengths of Front and Back.

Weave in rem ends.
