



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 12¾"

Length: 20" with cuff folded

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns So...Woolly (40% Wool, 60% Acrylic; 7oz/200g, 94yds/86m)

- 1112-05 Cream – 2 balls

Needle: US Size 15 (10 mm) dpns, US Size 17 (12.5 mm) dpns (or desired needles for working small circumferences in the rnd) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, cable needle, stitch markers in two colors (one to mark beginning of rnd, 4 to mark cable panels), 12mm crochet hook (for hanging loop)

GAUGE

10 sts x 11 rows = 4" in Rev St st with larger needles

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

Stocking is worked from the top down in the round with short row heel shaping. Shown with So...Woolly Fireside Crochet Stocking (pattern available on www.premieryarns.com)

STITCH GUIDE

K1, P1 Rib in the rnd (*multiple of 2 sts*)

Every Rnd: *K1, p1; rep from * around.

2/2RC (2/2 Right Cross): Slip 2 sts onto cable needle and hold in back, k2, k2 from cable needle.

2/2LC (2/2 Left Cross): Slip 2 sts onto cable needle and hold in front, k2, k2 from cable needle.

Braided Cable (8-st panel)

Rnd 1 and all odd numbered rnds: Knit.

Rnd 2: K2, 2/2 LC, k2.

Rnd 4: K4, 2/2 LC.

Rnd 6: K2, 2/2 RC, k2.

Rnd 8: 2/2 RC, k4.

Rep Rnds 1-8 for pattern.

STOCKING

Cuff

With smaller dpns, cast on 32 sts, pm, join for working in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work in **K1, P1 Rib in the rnd** for 5".

Leg

Switch to larger dpns.

Setup Rnd: *P4, pm in second color, work Rnd 1 of **Braided Cable** over next 8 sts, pm, p4; rep from * around.

Work in est'd patt, working **Braided Cable** between markers until piece measures 15" from cast-on, ending with Rnd 8 of **Braided Cable**.

Heel

Row 1 (RS): P4, sm, work Rnd 1 of **Braided Cable** over next 8 sts, sm, p7, w&t.

Row 2 (WS): K6, w&t.

Row 3: P5, w&t.

Row 4: K4, w&t.

Braided Cable Stocking

Level: Intermediate

Note: For the remainder of Heel shaping, work wraps and sts together as you come to them.

Row 5: P6, sm, w&t.

Row 6: K3, sm, w&t.

Row 7: Sm, P6, w&t.

Row 8: K4, w&t.

Row 9: P5, w&t.

Row 10: K6, w&t.

Row 11: P7, w&t.

Row 12: K8, w&t.

Row 13: P8, sm, work Rnd 1 of **Braided Cable** over next 8 sts, sm, p4.

Foot

Beg with Rnd 2 of **Braided Cable**, continue working in pattern as established for 6" more, working **Braided Cable** between markers, removing markers for Cable panel on last rnd.

Toe

Setup Rnd: P8, pm, p16, pm, p8.

Dec Rnd: *Purl to 3 sts before marker, p2tog, p1, sm, p2tog, rep from * once more, purl to end – 4 sts dec'd. Rep Dec Rnd, 5 more times – 8 sts rem.

FINISHING

Cut yarn leaving 12" tail. Thread yarn through tapestry needle, pull through each remaining st, removing from needle as you go. Pull tail to draw closed. Secure end to wrong side of work.

Hanging Loop

With crochet hook, make a chain 6" long. Fasten off. Fold chain in half to form loop. Sew to inside of top of Stocking.

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

beg	begin(ning)
dec'd	decreased
dpns	double pointed needles
est'd	established
k	knit
patt	pattern
p	purl
p2tog	purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
pm	place marker
rem	remain(ing)
rep	repeat(ing)
rnd(s)	round(s)
Rev St st	Reverse Stockinette stitch: Purl on RS rows, knit on WS rows.
RS	right side
st(s)	stitch(es)
sm	slip marker
w&t	wrap and turn: with yarn to WS, slip next st to right hand needle, move yarn to RS, slip st back to left hand needle, turn work to begin next row
WS	wrong side
