

## Mock Cable Beanie

## SIZES

Child's Large/Women's Small
(Women's Medium)
Shown in Size Women's Small

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Hat Circumference: 16 (18)" measured with
rib relaxed; to fit head circumference: 20 (22)"
Length: 9 (10)"

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns So...Woolly ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ (60\% Acrylic, $40 \%$ Wool; 6oz/170g, $80 y d s / 73 \mathrm{~m}$ )

- 1112-14 Teal - 1 ball

Needle: US Size 17 ( 12 mm ) 16 " circular needles and dpns or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

## GAUGE

7 sts $\times 10$ rows = $4^{\prime \prime}$ in Mock Cable Pattern Save time, check your gauge.

## STITCH GUIDE

K3, P2 Rib (multiple of 5 sts)
Every Rnd: *K3, p2; rep from * around.
RT - Right Twist - K2tog but do not drop sts from left-hand needle; insert right hand needle between 2 sts just worked and knit first st again, slip both sts from left-hand needle together

Mock Cable Pattern (multiple of 5 sts) Rnd 1: *K1, RT, p2; rep from * to end. Rnd 2: *RT, k1, p2; rep from * to end. Rnds 3-4: Knit. Rep Rnds 1-4 for pattern.

## HAT

With circular needles, cast on 40 (45) sts; pm, join to work in the rnd being careful not to twist sts.
Work in K3, P2 Rib until piece measures 2". Work in Mock Cable Pattern until piece measures 8 (9)", ending having worked Rnd 2 of pattern.

## Shape Crown

Note: Switch to dpns when work no longer fits on circular needle.
Rnd 1: *K3, p2tog; rep from * around 32 (36) sts.
Rnd 2: *K3tog; p1; rep from * around 16 (18) sts.
Rnd 3: *K2tog; rep from * around -
8 (9) sts.
Cut yarn, leaving a long tail.

## FINISHING

Thread yarn onto tapestry needle and draw through remaining sts.
Pull to close.
Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

dpn(s) double point needle(s)
k
k2tog knit 2 sts together ( 1 st dec'd)
k3tog knit 3 sts together (2 sts dec'd)
p
pm place marker
p2tog purl 2 sts together ( 1 st dec'd)
rep repeat(ing)
rnd(s) round(s)
st(s) stitch(es)
