



# Woolly Winter Beanie

Level: Intermediate

## SIZES

Women's Average

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Circumference:** 17"

**Height (not including pompom):** 9½"

## MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns So Woolly** (60% Acrylic, 40% Wool; 6oz/170g, 80yds/73m)

- #1124-02 Vintage – 1 ball

**Hook:** US Size P/Q (15 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, large pompom maker, removable stitch marker

## GAUGE

7.5 sts x 8 rows = 4" in Half Double Crochet blo

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## PATTERN NOTES

The ribbed brim is worked flat in one piece and then joined together to begin working in the round for the rest of the beanie. Once working in the round, beanie is worked in a spiral. Do not join at the end of rounds. Use a removable stitch marker to mark the first st of the round, and move the marker up with each subsequent round.

## BRIM

Ch 8.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and each ch across. Ch 1, turn – 7 sc.

**Row 2:** Sc blo in each sc across. Ch 1, turn – 7 sc blo.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures approx. 17½".

Do not fasten off. You will now join one short side of the brim to the other to being working in the rnd. Sl st in the back loop of the last row to the front loop of the 1st row and sl st short sides of band together. Do not cut yarn.

You will now begin working in the rnd. From the right side, sc 32 sts around the edge. Place a stitch marker to indicate the first st of the rnd.

## BEANIE

**Rnd 1:** Hdc blo in each st around – 32 hdc blo. Rep Rnd 1 until piece measures approx. 5" including brim (or for 4 more rnds).

## Begin decrease rnds:

**Rnd 1:** \*Hdc in next 6 hdc, hdc2tog; rep from \* around – 28 hdc, 4 hdc dec'd.

**Rnd 2:** \*Hdc blo in next 5 hdc, hdc2tog blo; rep from \* around – 24 hdc, 4 hdc dec'd.

**Rnd 3:** \*Hdc blo in next 4 hdc, hdc2tog blo; rep from \* around – 20 hdc, 4 hdc dec'd.

**Rnd 4:** \*Hdc blo in next 3 hdc, hdc2tog blo; rep from \* around – 16 hdc, 4 hdc dec'd.

**Rnd 5:** \*Hdc blo in next 2 hdc, hdc2tog blo; rep from \* around – 12 hdc, 4 hdc dec'd.

**Rnd 6:** \*Hdc blo in next hdc, hdc2tog blo; rep from \* around – 8 hdc, 4 hdc dec'd.

**Rnd 7:** Hdc2tog around – 4 hdc, 4 hdc dec'd.

## FINISHING

Cut yarn, leaving a 12" tail. Use tapestry needle to thread yarn through each st on the final rnd. Pull the top of the beanie closed and fasten off.

Use pompom maker to make pompom according to manufacturer's instructions. With tapestry needle, sew pompom to top of beanie.

Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

<b>blo</b>	back loop only
<b>ch</b>	chain
<b>dec'd</b>	decreased
<b>hdc</b>	half double crochet
<b>hdc2tog</b>	half double crochet the next 2 sts together (1 st dec)
<b>rep</b>	repeat(ing)
<b>rnd(s)</b>	round(s)
<b>sc</b>	single crochet
<b>sl st</b>	slip stitch
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
