



Classic Knit Beanie

SIZES

Adult Small (Medium, Large)
Shown in Size Adult Small

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 19 (20½, 21¾)''

Height: 10 (10¼, 10½)''

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Sofie* (88% Acrylic, 8% Polyamide, 4% Viscose; 1.75oz/50g, 93yds/85m)

- 1152-19 Pearl – 1 (2, 2) ball(s)

Needle: US Size 10 (6 mm) 16'' circular needle and set of dpns, US Size 9 (5.5 mm) 16'' circular needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, pompom maker

GAUGE

11 sts x 15 rows = 4'' in St st

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/ techniques used in this pattern:

- Knitting in the round
- Small circumference knitting on dpns
- Knit and purl stitches
- K2tog and ssk decreases

STITCH GUIDE

2x2 Rib (*multiple 4 sts*)

Rnd 1: *K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

The Beanie is worked from the bottom up in the round.

BEANIE

With smaller needle, cast on 52 (56, 60) sts, pm and join to work in the rnd. Work even in **2x2 Rib** until piece meas 1½'' from the cast-on edge.

Switch to larger needle, work even in St st until piece meas 8'' from cast-on edge.

Crown Shaping

Cont in est'd patt, switch to dpns when sts no longer fit comfortably on circular needle.

Setup Rnd: *K13 (14, 15) sts, pm; rep from * 3 times, k13 (14, 15).

Dec Rnd: *K2tog, knit to 2 sts bef m, ssk, sm; rep from * to end – 8 sts dec'd.

All other rnds: Knit.

Rep Dec Rnd every other rnd 4 (5, 5) more times – 12 (8, 12) sts rem.

Next Rnd (Sizes S and L only): *K2tog; rep from * to end – 6 sts rem.

All Sizes: Cut yarn leaving a long tail, thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through 6 (8, 6) rem sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

k2tog	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
k	knit
m	marker
meas	measure
p	purl
patt	pattern
pm	place marker
rep	repeat(ing)
rnd(s)	round(s)
ssk	slip slip knit (1 st dec'd)
sm	slip marker
st(s)	stitch(es)
St st	Stockinette stitch: knit every rnd.
