

Mock Cable Cocoon

SIZES

S/M (L/1X, 2X/3X)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 35 (43, 51)" excluding cuffs Length: 22½ (24, 25½)" excluding collar

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Sofie* (88% Acrylic, 8% Polyamide, 4% Viscose; 1.75oz/50g, 93yds/85m)

• #1152-01 Eggshell – 8 (10, 12) balls **Needle:** US Size 10½ (6.5 mm) knitting needle or size needed to obtain gauge **Notions:** Tapestry needle

GAUGE

10 sts x 18 rows = 4" in Mock Cable Lace **Save time, check your gauge.**

STITCH GUIDE

Mock Cable Lace (multiple of 4 sts + 2)
Row 1 (RS): *P2, k2; rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.
WS Rows 2 and 6: *K2, p2; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 3: P1, yo, *k2tog, ssk, yo twice; rep from * to last 5 sts, k2tog, ssk, yo, p1.

Row 4: K2, p2, *k1, k1 tbl, p2; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 5: P2, *RT, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, RT, p2.

Rep Rows 1-6 for pattern. Chart on next page.

Fisherman's Rib (multiple of 2 + 1)

Row 1: K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to end. Row 2: P1, *k1b, p1; rep from * to end. Row 3: K1, *p1, k1b; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1. Rep Rows 2-3 for pattern.

COCOON

Body

Cast on 158 (178, 198) sts. Work in **Mock Cable Lace** until piece measures 18 (19, 20)" from cast-on.

Shape Back Panel

Bind off 60 sts at beginning of next 2 rows – 38 (58, 78) sts rem.

Back Panel

Work in **Mock Cable Lace** for $4\frac{1}{2}$ (5, $5\frac{1}{2}$)". Bind off.

Sleeve Cuffs (Make 2)

Cast on 29 (33, 37) sts. Work in **Fisherman's Rib** for 7". Bind off.

FINISHING

Fold Body of Cocoon in half lengthwise, matching cast-on edge to bound off sts for Back Panel. Fold sleeve cuff in half matching center point with center point of the fold for Body. Sew Sleeve Cuffs to Body. Sew Sleeve and Body Seam. See Diagram on next page.

Edging

Note: If you prefer, the Edging can be knit separately and then sewn onto the finished piece.

Cast on 25 sts. Beg with RS facing at bottom right edge of Back Panel.

Row 1: Work Row 1 of **Fisherman's Rib**, pick up and knit 1 st in Back Panel edge.

Row 2: P2tog (counts as first p1), work Row 2 of Fisherman's Rib.

project continued

Row 3: Work Row 3 of **Fisherman's Rib**, pick up and knit 1 st in Back Panel edge.

Rep Rows 2-3 along the entire opening of Cocoon.

Bind off all sts.

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

beg begin(ning)
dec('d) decrease(d)

k knit

k1b insert your right needle into the stitch from

the row below the first st on the left needle, knitwise; knit as normal bringing the yarn through the st, allowing the st to fall off the

left-hand needle

k2tog knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

p pur

p2tog purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

rep
repeat(ing)
RS right side

RT right twist; k2tog but do not drop sts from

left-hand needle; insert right hand needle between 2 sts just worked and knit first st again, slip both sts from left-hand needle

together

ssk slip slip knit (1 st dec'd)

st(s) stitch(es)

tbl through the back loop

WS wrong sideyo yarn over
