

Striped Tube Cowl

## SIZES

## One Size

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

## Circumference: 28"

Height: 11"

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Sofie (88\% Acrylic, 8\% Polyamide, 4\% Viscose; 1.75oz/50g, 93yds/85m)

- C1: 1152-01 Eggshell-1 ball
- C2: 1152-11 Celery - 1 ball
- C3: 1152-19 Pearl-1 ball
- C4: 1152-16 Oat - 1 ball

Needle: US Size 10 ( 6 mm ) 16" circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

## GAUGE

11 sts x 15 rnds = 4" in St st
Save time, check your gauge.

## STITCH GUIDE

Stripe Pattern (any number of sts)
Rnds 1-6: With C1, knit.
Rnds 7-12: With C2, knit.
Rnds 13-18: With C3, knit.
Rnds 19-26: With C4, knit.
Rep Rnds 1-26 for patt.

## PATTERN NOTES

This Cowl is worked in a tube and the ends are seamed together. To prevent a jog when switching colors, slip the first stitch purlwise on the second round of each stripe. If you prefer, you can use a provisional cast on and then use Kitchener stitch or a three-needle bind off to close the Cowl.

## COWL

With C1, cast on 60 sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work even in Stripe Pattern. Rep Stripe
Pattern, 3 more times for a total of 104 rnds, approximately $273 / 4$ ", end having just finished a C4 stripe. Bind off all sts.

## FINISHING

Seam open ends together forming a tube, with the stripes going vertically.
Weave in ends.
Wash and block to Finished Measurements, if desired.

C color
patt pattern
pm place marker
rep repeat(ing)
rnd(s) round(s)
st(s) stitch(es)
St st Stockinette stitch: knit every rnd.
