## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

### HAT

**Circumference:** 17"  
**Height:** 9"

### SCARF:

**Length:** 57"  
**Width:** 8"

### MITTS

**Circumference:** 6"

## MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Spun Colors** (65% Acrylic, 35% Fine Merino Superwash; 7oz/200g, 419yds/384m)

- Hat and Mitts: #1110-03 Blue Ridge – 1 ball each
- Scarf: #1110-03 Blue Ridge – 2 balls

**Needles:** US Size 8 (5 mm) 16" circular needle and set of double point needles, US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular (optional) and set of double point needles *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers, waste yarn, large pompom maker (optional)

## GAUGE

20 sts x 28 rows = 4" in Alternating Slip Stitch with larger needle

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## STITCH GUIDE

**2X2 Rib** (*multiple of 4 sts*)

**Rnd 1:** \*K2, p2; rep from \* to end.  
Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

**Alternating Slip Stitch in the Round** (*multiple of 4 sts, slip all sts pwise wyib*)

**Rnds 1-4:** \*K2, sl 1, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 5:** Knit.

**Rnd 6:** \*P2, k1, p1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnds 7-10:** \*Sl 1, k3; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 11:** Knit.

**Rnd 12:** \*K1, p3; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnds 1-12 for patt.

**Alternating Slip Stitch** (*multiple of 4+3 sts, slip sts on RS pwise wyib, on WS pwise wyif*)

**Rows 1 and 3 (RS):** K3, \*k2, sl 1, k1; rep from \* to the last 4 sts, k4.

**Rows 2 and 4 (WS):** K2, p2, \*p1, sl 1, p2; rep from \* to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

**Row 5:** Knit.

**Row 6:** K4, \*k1, p1, k2; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3.

**Rows 7 and 9:** K3, \*sl 1, k3; rep from \* to last 4 sts, sl 1, k3.

**Rows 8 and 10:** K2, p1, sl 1, \*p3, sl 1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, p1, k2.

**Row 11:** Knit.

**Row 12:** K3, p1, \*k3, p1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3.

Rep Rows 1-12 for patt.

**CDD (Centered Double Decrease):** Sl 2 sts together, k1, p2sso — 2 sts dec'd.

## PATTERN NOTES

The Hat and Mitts are worked from the bottom up in the round. The Scarf is worked flat in one piece with optional fringe on the ends.

# Slip Stitch Hat, Scarf, and Mitts

Level: Intermediate

## HAT

With smaller circular needle or dpns, cast on 100 sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work even in **2X2 Rib** until piece meas 2" from cast on edge.

Switch to larger needle and work even in **Alternating Slip Stitch in the Round** until piece meas approx. 7.5" from cast on edge or to desired height, end having just worked Rnd 12 of patt.

## Crown Shaping

*Note: If working on circular needle, switch to dpns when necessary.*

**Rnd 1:** \*[K2, sl 1, k1] 4 times, k1, CDD, pm; rep from \* to end, do not pm at end of last rep — 10 sts dec'd, 90 sts rem.

**Rnd 2:** \*[K2, sl 1, k1] 4 times, knit to m; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 3:** \*[K2, sl 1, k1] 3 times, k2, sl 1, CDD; rep from \* to end — 10 sts dec'd, 80 sts rem.

**Rnd 4:** \*K2, sl 1, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 5:** \*Knit to 3 sts bef m, CDD; rep from \* to end — 10 sts dec'd, 70 sts rem.

**Rnd 6:** \*[P2, k1, p1] 3 times, p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 7:** \*[Sl 1, k3] twice, sl 1, k2, CDD; rep from \* to end — 10 sts dec'd, 60 sts rem.

**Rnd 8:** \*Sl 1, k3; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 9:** \*[Sl 1, k3] twice, sl 1, CDD; rep from \* to end — 10 sts dec'd, 50 sts rem.

**Rnd 10:** \*[Sl 1, k3] twice, sl 1, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 11:** \*Knit to 3 sts bef m, CDD; rep from \* to end — 10 sts dec'd, 40 sts rem.

**Rnd 12:** \*K1, p3, k1, p2, k1; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 13:** \*K2, sl 1, k2, CDD; rep from \* to end — 10 sts dec'd, 30 sts rem.

**Rnd 14:** \*K2, sl 1, k1, k2tog; rep from \* to end — 5 sts dec'd, 25 sts rem.

**Rnd 15:** \*K2, sl 1, k2tog; rep from \* to end — 5 sts dec'd, 20 sts rem.

**Rnd 16:** \*K2, k2tog; rep from \* to end — 5 sts dec'd, 15 sts rem.

**Rnd 17:** \*K1, k2tog; rep from \* to end — 5 sts dec'd, 10 sts rem.

Cut yarn.

## FINISHING

Thread tail onto tapestry needle, draw through remaining sts and pull tight to secure. Optional - make pompom and attach to crown. Weave in ends.

## MITTS (Make 2)

With smaller set of dpns, cast on 36 sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work even in **2X2 Rib** until piece meas 2" from cast on edge. Switch to larger set of dpns and work even in **Alternating Slip Stitch in the Round** until piece meas approx. 4" from cast on edge, end having just worked Rnd 4 or 10 of patt.

**Thumbhole Rnd:** With waste yarn, k7, sl 7 sts back to RHN and knit again with working yarn; cont in patt to end.

Cont in est'd patt until piece meas 2" from Thumbhole Rnd, or to desired length.

Switch to smaller set of dpns and work even in **2X2 Rib** for 1", bind off in rib.

## Thumb

Undo waste yarn and place the 13 live sts on 2 of the smaller dpns (7 sts on one and 6 sts on the other). Join working yarn and pm to indicate beg/end of rnd. K7, pick up and knit 2 sts bet ndls, k6, pick up and knit 2 sts bet ndls — 17 sts.

**Next Rnd:** K2tog, k1, p2, work in **2X2 Rib** to end. Work 4 rnds in **2X2 Rib**, then bind off in rib.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## SCARF

With larger needle, cast on 39 sts, knit 2 rows (4 rows if omitting fringe). Work in **Alternating Slip Stitch** until piece meas 60" or to desired length. Knit 2 rows (4 rows if omitting fringe), bind off.

## FINISHING

### Fringe

Cut 32 - 12" lengths of yarn, attach in groups of 2, approx 1" apart, on each end of Scarf. Weave in ends.
