Textured Ripple Scarf

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: Approx. 60" Width: 10"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Spun Colors* (65% Acrylic, 35% Fine Superwash Merino; 7oz/200g, 419yds/384m)

#1110-02 Mauve – 3 balls (MC)

#1110-04 Iris – 1 ball (CC)
Hook: US Size H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

14 sc x 16 rows = 4" in Textured Ripple Stitch **Save time, check your gauge.**

STITCH GUIDE

Textured Ripple Stitch (multiples of 9+3) Begin with MC.

Row 1 (WS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 4 chs, 3 sc in next ch; *sc in next 3 chs, sk next 2 chs, sc in next 3 chs, 3 sc in next ch; rep from * across to last 5 chs, sc in last 5 chs; ch 1, turn. **Row 2 (RS):** Working in the back loop only, sc2tog first 2 sc, sc in next 4 sc, 3 sc in next sc; *sc in next 3 sc, sk next 2 sc, sc in next 3 sc, 3 sc in next sc; rep from * to last 6 sc, sc in next 4

sc, sc2tog last 2 sc, ch 1, turn.

Rows 3-5 Rep Row 2. And the end of Row 5, do not ch 1. Break MC.

Row 6: With RS facing you and CC, working through both loops, sl st loosely in each sc across. Break CC.

Row 7: With WS facing you and MC, leaving sl sts of previous row unworked and working in back loops only of sc of Row 5, rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 2-7 for patt.

SCARF

Ch 57. Work **Textured Ripple Stitch** until piece measures approx. 60" long. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
