



Waterfall Cardigan

Level: Intermediate

SIZES

Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X)
Shown in Size S with 2" positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Back Width: 17¼ (19¼, 21¼, 23¼, 26¼, 28¼)"
Length: 29¼ (29½, 30½, 30¾, 31¼, 31½)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Spun Colors (65% Acrylic, 35% Fine Merino Superwash; 7oz/200g, 419yds/384m)

- 1110-01 Agate – 4 (4, 5, 6, 6, 7) balls
- Needles:** US Size 8 (5 mm) straight needles and US Size 7 (4.5 mm) straight needles and 24" or longer circular needle

or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, locking stitch markers

GAUGE

18 sts x 24 rows = 4" in St st
14 sts x 20 rows in Waterfall patt
Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Waterfall (*multiple of 9 sts*)

Rows 1, 3 and 5 (RS): *[K1, yo] 3 times, [k2tog] 3 times; rep from * to end.

WS rows 2-12: Purl.

Rows 7, 9 and 11: *K1, [ssk] 3 times, [yo, k1] twice, yo; rep from * to end.

Rep Rows 1-12 for patt.

1X1 Rib (*even number of sts*)

Row 1 (RS): K1, *k1, p1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2 (WS): P1, *k1, p1; rep from * to last st, p1.

Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

This cardigan is worked from the bottom up in pieces and seamed. The neck edging is picked up and worked once the cardigan has been assembled. Choose a size where the back width is approximately 4-6" larger than your cross-back measurement (underarm to underarm).

CARDIGAN

Back

With smaller needles, cast on 64 (71, 78, 85, 94, 103) sts. Work even in Garter st until piece meas 1½" from cast on edge. Switch to larger needles.

Row 1 (RS): K5 (4, 3, 2, 2, 2), work even in **Waterfall** patt to last 5 (4, 3, 2, 2, 2) sts, k5 (4, 3, 2, 2, 2).

Row 2 (WS): P5 (4, 3, 2, 2, 2), work even in **Waterfall** patt to last 5 (4, 3, 2, 2, 2) sts, p5 (4, 3, 2, 2, 2).

Continue in est'd patt until piece meas 29¼ (29½, 30½, 30¾, 31¼, 31½)" from cast on edge, bind off all sts.

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Right Front

With smaller needles, cast on 69 (76, 83, 90, 99, 108) sts. Work even in Garter st until piece meas 1½" from cast on edge. Switch to larger needles.

Row 1 (RS): K10 (9, 8, 7, 7, 7), work even in **Waterfall** patt to last 5 (4, 3, 2, 2, 2) sts, k5 (4, 3, 2, 2, 2).

Row 2 (WS): P5 (4, 3, 2, 2, 2), work even in **Waterfall** patt to last 10 (9, 8, 7, 7, 7), sts, p5 (4, 3, 2, 2, 2), k5. Continue in est'd patt until piece meas 29¼ (29½, 30½, 30¾, 31¼, 31½)" from cast on edge, bind off all sts.

Left Front

With smaller needles, cast on 68 (75, 82, 89, 98, 107) sts. Work even in Garter st until piece meas 1½" from cast on edge. Switch to larger needles.

Row 1 (RS): K5 (4, 3, 2, 2, 2), work even in **Waterfall** patt to last 10 (9, 8, 7, 7, 7) sts, k10 (9, 8, 7, 7, 7).

Row 2 (WS): K5, p5 (4, 3, 2, 2, 2), work even in **Waterfall** patt to last 5 (4, 3, 2, 2, 2), sts, p5 (4, 3, 2, 2, 2). Continue in est'd patt until piece meas 29¼ (29½, 30½, 30¾, 31¼, 31½)" from cast on edge, bind off all sts.

Sleeves (Make 2)

With smaller needles, cast on 40 (40, 40, 40, 42, 42) sts. Work even in **1X1 Rib** until piece meas 2½" from cast on edge. Switch to larger needles, work 8 (8, 8, 6, 6, 2) rows even in St st.

Inc Row (RS): K1, kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 — 2 sts inc'd.

All other rows: Work even in est'd patt. Rep Inc Row every 6th row 16 (12, 6, 3, 1, 0) more time(s), and then every 4th row 0 (6, 15, 20, 23, 26) times — 32 (36, 42, 46, 48, 52) sts inc'd, 74 (78, 84, 88, 92, 96) sts total. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Wash and block pieces, if desired.

Seaming

Place locking markers 4½ (5½, 6¼, 7¼, 8½, 9½)" from each side along the top edge. Seam Right and Left Front to Back at the top edges from each side to marker. Place locking markers at the center top of each Sleeve, sew to sides, aligning marker with shoulder seam. Seam Fronts, Back and Sleeves along each side.

Neck Edging

With smaller circular needle and RS facing, pick up and knit 132 (141, 150, 159, 166, 181) sts along the top edge of Right Front, Back neck and Left Front. Work 1½" in Garter st, bind off all sts.

Weave in ends.

est'd	established
Garter st	Knit every row.
inc('d)	increase(d)
k	knit
kfb	knit into the front and back of the next st (1 st inc'd)
k2tog	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
meas	measures
p	purl
patt	pattern
rep	repeat(ing)
RS	right side
ssk	slip slip knit (1 st dec'd)
st(s)	stitch(es)
St st	Stockinette stitch: knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows.
WS	wrong side
yo	yarn over

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
