



Zoe Turtleneck

Level: Easy

SIZES

Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X)
Shown in Small Size with approx. 4" positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 40 (44½, 48, 52½, 56, 60½)"
Length: 20 (20¾, 21, 21¾, 22, 22¾)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Spun Colors* (65% Acrylic, 35% Fine Merino Superwash; 7oz/200g, 419yds/384m)

- 1110-12 Rustic – 3 (4, 4, 5, 5, 6) balls
- Needle:** US Size 8 (5 mm) straight needles, US Size 7 (4.5 mm) straight needles and 16" circular needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*
Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch holder or waste yarn, stitch marker, locking stitch markers

GAUGE

17 sts x 23 rows = 4" in Rev St st with larger needle

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

1X1 Rib (*multiple of 2 sts*)

Row 1: *K1, p1; rep from * to end.
Rep Row 1 for patt.

1X1 Rib in the Round (*multiple of 2 sts*)

Rnd 1: *K1, p1; rep from * to end.
Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

Reverse Stockinette Stitch (Rev St st): Purl on RS Rows, knit on WS rows.

PATTERN NOTES

This Pullover is worked from the bottom up in pieces and seamed. The neck edging is picked up and worked in the round once seaming is complete.

PULLOVER

Back

With smaller needles, cast on 92 (102, 110, 120, 128, 138) sts.

Work even in **1X1 Rib** until piece meas 3".

Switch to larger needles. Work even in **Rev St st** until piece meas 20 (20¾, 21, 21¾, 22, 22¾)" from cast-on edge. Bind off all sts.

Front

With smaller needles, cast on 92 (102, 110, 120, 128, 138) sts.

Work even in **1X1 Rib** until piece meas 3".

Switch to larger needles. Work even in **Rev St st** until piece meas 18 (18¾, 19, 19¾, 20, 20¾)" from cast-on edge. End having just worked a WS row.

Neck Shaping

Row 1 (RS): P32 (37, 40, 45, 49, 53), bind off 28 (28, 30, 30, 30, 32) sts, purl to end, place left shoulder sts on stitch holder or waste yarn.

Row 2 (WS): Knit.

Dec Row (RS): P1, ssp, purl to end — 1 st dec'd.

Next Row: Knit.

Rep these 2 rows 4 more times — 4 sts dec'd, 27 (32, 35, 40, 44, 48) sts rem.

Bind off sts.

By Premier® Yarns Design Team

Place held sts on working needle and with RS facing, join yarn.

Dec Row (RS): Purl to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1— 1 st dec'd.

Next Row: Knit.

Rep these 2 rows 4 more times —

4 sts dec'd, 27 (32, 35, 40, 44, 48) sts rem.

Bind off all sts.

Sleeves (Make 2)

With smaller needles, cast on 40 (44, 44, 44, 48, 48) sts. Work even in **1X1 Rib** until piece meas 3". Switch to larger needles and work 8 (8, 8, 8, 6, 6) rows even in **Rev St st**.

Inc Row (RS): P1, pfb, work even in patt to last 3 sts, pfb, p1 — 2 sts inc'd.

All other rows: Work even in patt.

Rep Inc Row every every 4th row 1 (1, 10, 15, 15, 21) more time(s) and then every 6th row 15 (15, 9, 6, 6, 2) times — 32 (32, 38, 42, 46, 46) sts inc'd, 74 (78, 84, 88, 92, 96) sts.

Work even until Sleeve meas 21" from cast-on edge, bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Wash and block Front, Back and Sleeves, if desired.

Sew shoulder seams, place locking marker at the top center of each Sleeve. Use marker to align center of Sleeve with shoulder seam, sew Sleeves along the edge of Front and Back. Seam the Sleeves and then the Front and Back.

Neck Edging

With RS facing and circ, pick up and knit 84 (84, 88, 88, 88, 92) sts around neck opening, pm and join for working in the rnd.

Work even in **1X1 Rib** until Neck Edging meas 7½", loosely bind off all sts in rib.

Weave in ends.

p2tog	purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
patt	pattern
pfb	purl into the front and back of the next st (1 st inc'd)
pm	place marker
rem	remain(ing)
rep	repeat(ing)
rnd(s)	round(s)
RS	right side
ssp	slip slip purl (1 st dec'd)
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	wrong side
