Double Brim Beanie

Type : Crochet

Level : Intermediate

Double Brim Beanie

Materials

Premier® Yarns *Stitch Please™ Chunky* (100% Wool; 3.5oz/100g, 120yds/110m)

- 1135-14 Denim Daydream – 2 skeins

Hook

US Size J-10 (6 mm) 24" crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions

Tapestry Needle

Stitch Marker

Sizes

One Size

Finished Measurements

Circumference: 20"

Height: 10"

Gauge

10 sts x 10 rows = 4" in patt

Save time, check your gauge.

Pattern Notes

This Beanie is made from the bottom up. The Double Brim piece is made flat first and then seamed to work the remainder of the Beanie in the round.

Beanie Instructions

Double Brim

Ch 17.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn – 16 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc blo in each sc across, turn.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures 22" long.

Note: You will now join one side of the brim to the other to being working in the rnd.

Sc short ends of brim together. Do not cut yarn. Fold brim in half lengthwise and sl st the 2 long ends together to make a double thick brim. From the right side, sc 60 sts along the folded edge of the hat. Place a marker to indicate the first st of the rnd.

Body

Rnd 1: *Sc in next st, dc in next st; rep from * to end. Rep Rnd 1 until piece measures 7" from bottom of brim.

Crown Shaping

Rnd 1: *Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * around – 50 sts, 10 sts dec'd.

Rnd 2: *Sc in next st, dc in next st; rep from * around.

Rnd 3: *Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around – 40 sts, 10 sts dec'd.

Rnd 4: Rep Rnd 2.

Rnd 5: *Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around – 30 sts, 10 sts dec'd.

Rnd 6: *Sc2tog, sc in next sc; rep from * around – 20 sts, 10 sts dec'd.

Rnd 7: *Sc2tog; rep from * around – 10 sts, 10 sts dec'd.

Fasten off, leaving a 12" tail.

Finishing

Use tapestry needle to thread yarn through every other st on the final rnd. Pull the top of the hat closed and fasten off. Weave in all ends.

dec'd	decrease(d)
dc	double crochet
patt	pattern
rep	repeat(ing)
rnd(s)	round(s)
sc	single crochet
sc2tog	single crochet the next 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
sl st	slip stitch
st(s)	stitch(es)
