Slipping Hat and Mitts

Materials

Premier® Yarns *Stitch Please™ Chunky* (100% Wool; 3.5oz/100g, 120yds/110m)

- C1: 1135-32 Irrelephant – 2 skeins
- C2: 1135-02 Stay Gold – 1 skein
- C3: 1135-06 Jam Session – 1 skein
- C4: #135-18 Adora-bubble – 1 skein

Needles

US Size 10 (6 mm) 16" circular needle and/or set of double pointed needles

US Size 8 (5 mm) 16" circular needle and/or set of dpns, *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions

Tapestry Needle

Stitch Marker

Sizes

HAT

Adult Small (Medium, Large)

MITTS

Adult XS/Small (Medium/Large)

Finished Measurements

HAT

Circumference: 18¼ (20½, 22¾)"

Height: 10¾"

MITTS

Circumference: 6¾ (8)"

Height: 7 (7)"

Gauge

14 sts x 28 rows = 4" in St st with larger needle

Save time, check your gauge.

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Pattern Notes

The Hat is worked from the bottom up in the round. All stitches are slipped purlwise with the yarn in back. The Mitts are worked from the bottom up in the round with an afterthought thumb.

Pattern Stitch Guide

Slipped Stripes (*multiple of 4 sts*)

Rnds 1 and 2: With C2, *sl 1, k3; rep from * to end.

Rnds 3 and 4: With C3, *k2, sl 1, k1; rep from * to end.

Rnds 5 and 6: With C4, as Rnds 1 and 2.

Rnds 7 and 8: With C1, as Rnds 3 and 4.

Rep Rnds 1-8 for patt.

2X2 Rib (*multiple of 4 sts*)

Rnd 1: *K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.



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Hat Instructions

With C1 and smaller needle, cast on 64 (72, 80) sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work even in **2X2 Rib** until piece meas 2" from cast on edge. Switch to larger needle and work 3 reps of **Slipped Stripes** patt and then Rnds 1-6 (30 rnds total).

Shape Crown

If working with a circular needle, switch to dpns when stitches no longer fit comfortably on needle.

Rnd 1: With C1, *k2, sl 1, k3, k2tog; rep from * to end — 8 (9, 10) sts dec'd, 56 (63, 70) sts rem.

Rnd 2: With C1, *k2, sl 1, k4; rep from * to end.

Rnd 3: With C2, *sl 1, k3, sl 1, k2tog; rep from * to end — 8 (9, 10) sts dec'd, 48 (54, 60) sts rem.

Rnd 4: With C2, *sl 1, k3, sl 1, k1; rep from * to end.

Rnd 5: With C3, *k2, sl 1, k1, k2tog; rep from * to end — 8 (9, 10) sts dec'd, 40 (45, 50) sts rem.

Rnd 6: With C3, *k2, sl 1, k2; rep from * to end.

Rnd 7: With C4, *sl 1, k2, k2tog; rep from * to end — 8 (9, 10) sts dec'd, 32 (36, 40) sts rem.

Rnd 8: With C4, *sl 1, k1, k2tog; rep from * to end — 8 (9, 10) sts dec'd, 24 (27, 30) sts rem.

Rnd 9: With C1, *k1, k2tog; rep from * to end — 8 (9, 10) sts dec'd, 16 (18, 20) sts rem.

Rnd 10: With C1, *k2tog; rep from * to end — 8 (9, 10) sts dec'd, 8 (9, 10) sts rem.

Cut yarn leaving a tail at least 6" long, thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through remaining sts.

Mitt Instructions

With C1 and smaller dpns, cast on 24 (28) sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work even in **2X2 Rib** until piece meas 2" from cast on edge. Switch to larger dpns and work in **Slipped Stripes** patt until piece meas 4" from cast-on edge, end having just worked a Row 4 or Row 8.

Thumbhole Rnd: With waste yarn, k4, sl 4 sts back to RHN and knit again with working yarn; cont in patt to end.

Cont in est'd patt until piece meas 2" from Thumbhole Rnd, or to desired length.

Switch to smaller set of dpns and work even in **2X2 Rib** for 1", bind off in rib.

Thumb

Undo waste yarn and place the 7 live sts on 2 of the smaller dpns (4 sts on one and 3 sts on the other). Join working yarn and pm to indicate beg/end of rnd. K4, pick up and knit 1 st bet ndls, k3, pick up and knit 1 sts bet ndls — 9 sts.

Next Rnd: K2tog, k1, p2, work in **2X2 Rib** to end. Work 4 rnds in **2X2 Rib**, then bind off in patt.

Rep for second Mitt.

Finishing

Weave in all ends. Wash and block to finished measurements.
