



Graphic Granny Mitts

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 8"

Length: 9"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Stitch Please™ Superwash Extra Fine Merino (100% Merino Wool; 1.75 oz/50g, 126yds/115m)

- MC: 2117-31 Black – 1 ball
- CC1: 2117-02 Marigold – 1 ball
- CC2: 2117-30 Graphite – 1 ball
- CC3: 2117-14 Peony – 1 ball

Hook: US Sizes F-5 (3.75 mm) & 7 (4.5 mm) or sizes needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

17 sts x 19 rows = 4" in Linen Stitch with larger hook

Granny Square = 4" wide with smaller hook

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in pattern:

- Chains, single, and half double crochet stitches.
- Back post single crochet.
- Decreasing.
- Changing colors.
- Working flat and in the round.
- Seaming.

STITCH GUIDE

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

Granny Square

Begin with **Magic Ring**.

Rnd 1: Ch 4 (counts as hdc + ch 2 here and throughout), *3 hdc in ring, ch 2; rep from * 2 more times, 2 hdc, join with sl st in second ch of beg ch-4.

Rnd 2: Ch 4, 3 hdc in same sp, ch 1, *(3 hdc, ch 2, 3 hdc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1; rep from * 2 more times, 2 hdc in same sp as beg hdc, join with sl st to second ch of beg ch-4.

Rnd 3: Ch 4, 3 hdc in same sp, ch 1, 3 hdc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, *(3 hdc, ch 2, 3 hdc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 hdc in ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from * 2 more times, 2 hdc in same sp as beg hdc, join with sl st to second ch of beg ch-4.

Rnd 4: Ch 4, 3 hdc in same sp, ch 1, (3 hdc in ch-1 sp, ch 1) 2 times, *(3 hdc, ch 2, 3 hdc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 hdc in ch-1 sp, ch 1) 2 times; rep from * 2 more times, 2 hdc in same sp as beg hdc, join with sl st to second ch of beg ch-4.

Fasten off.

Linen Stitch (even number of sts, worked in turned rounds)

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in first sc, ch 1, sk next sc, *sc in next sc, ch 1, sk next sc; rep from * around, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, *sc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk sc; rep from * around, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.
Rep Rnds 1-2 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

Granny squares form the hand of these fun and colorful mitts. Upper and lower edgings are added after mitts are complete. Cut colors after each Granny Square round and weave in ends.

MITTS (make 2)

Make two **Granny Squares** with smaller hook.

Seam one side of each **Granny Square** together. Seam the other sides together to form a tube along the first $\frac{3}{4}$ ", leave $2\frac{1}{2}$ " open for thumb hole, and seam rem $\frac{3}{4}$ " together.

Upper Edging

With larger hook, join MC to a corner sp of a **Granny Square** along one open side of tube.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in same sp, sc in next 16 sts and sps to end of **Granny Square**, work 17 sc along other **Granny Square**, join with sl st to beg sc – 34 sc. Work in **Linen Stitch** patt until Edging measures $1\frac{1}{2}$ ", switching to CC1 on final join. If the RS of the work is not already facing, turn so it is facing now.

Switch to smaller hook.

Next rnd (RS): Ch 1, sc in each st and sp around, join with sl st to beg sc.

Next rnd: Ch 1, bpsc in each sc around, join with sl st to beg sc.

Fasten off.

Lower Edging

With larger hook, join MC to a corner sp of a **Granny Square** along the other open side of tube.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in same sp, sc in next 16 sts and sps to end of **Granny Square**, work 17 sc along other **Granny Square**, join with sl st to beg sc – 34 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, (sc2tog, sc in next 4 sc) 5 times, sc2tog, sc in last 2 sc, join with sl st to beg sc – 28 sc rem. Work in **Linen Stitch** patt until Edging measures 3", switching to CC1 on final join. If the RS of the work is not already facing, turn so it is facing now.

Switch to smaller hook.

Next rnd (RS): Ch 1, sc in each st and sp around, join with sl st to beg sc.

Next rnd: Ch 1, bpsc in each sc around, join with sl st to beg sc.

Fasten off.

Thumb Edging

With smaller hook, join MC to unseamed thumb opening.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 22 sc evenly around opening, join with sl st to beg sc.

Switch to larger hook.

Rnds 2-3: Work **Linen Stitch** patt.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sl st in each st and sp around. Fasten off.

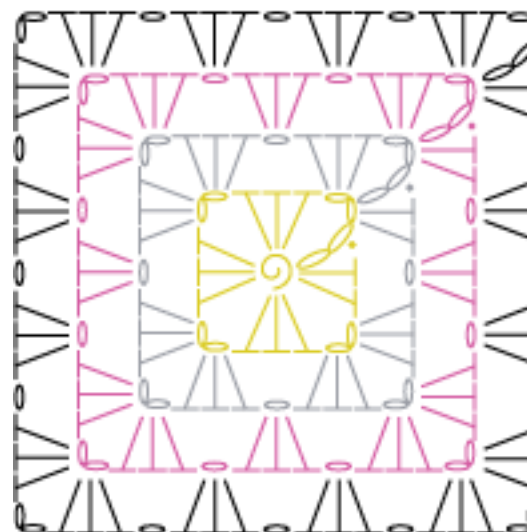
FINISHING

Weave in ends.

RS	right side
sc	single crochet
sc2tog	single crochet 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
sl st	slip stitch
sk	skip
sp	space
