



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 9¾"

Length: 80"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Stitch Please™* (100% Superwash Extra Fine Merino; 1.75oz/50g, 126yds/115m)

- 2117-17 Aubergine – 7 balls

Hook: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

15 hbhdc x 12 rows = 4"

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain and herringbone half double crochet stitches.
- Attaching Fringe.

STITCH GUIDE

Herringbone Half Double Crochet (HHDC): Yo, insert hook into next st and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), pull first loop through second loop only, yo and pull through rem 2 loops.

PATTERN NOTES

This Scarf is worked flat from end to end.

SCARF

Ch 39.

Row 1: HHDC in 3rd ch from hook and each ch across, turn – 37 HHDC.

Row 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st throughout), HHDC in each st across, turn – 37 HHDC.

Repeat Row 2 until Scarf measures 80" from foundation row. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Fringe

Cut 48 - 14" lengths of yarn. Holding 2 strands together, add Fringe at 12 sections (approximately every 3rd st) evenly across each end of the Scarf. Trim Fringe. Weave in all ends.

Abbreviations

ch chain
st(s) stitch(es)
yo yarn over
