Flower Power Wrap

Type : Crochet

Flower Power Wrap

Materials

Premier® Yarns *Stitch Please™ Superwash Worsted* (100% Superwash Wool; 3.5oz/100g, 220yds/200m)

- MC: 2034-36: Pearl – 3 balls
- CC1: 2034-37: Sunflower – 1 ball
- CC3: 2034-42: Rosy – 1 ball
- CC2: 2034-13: Capri – 1 ball

Hook

US Size H-8 (5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions

Tapestry needle, yarn bobbins

Size

One Size

Finished Measurements

Width: 15½

Length: 53¼

Gauge

13 hdc x 15 rows = 4"

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/Techniques used in pattern:

- Chain and half double crochet stitches.
- Changing colors in the intarsia crochet technique using bobbins.

Pattern Notes

This Wrap is worked from end to end using the crochet intarsia technique and following the color chart for color placement. To crochet using the intarsia technique, wind small bobbins of colors to be used for each separate area of color in the chart, changing colors according to the chart. To change color, work to last yarn over, pick up new color and pull through to complete stitch, drop the unused color attached to the bobbin to the wrong side of your work. Bobbins of yarn colors waiting to be used should always hang on the same side of your work (the wrong side.) It is acceptable to mix in small sections of tapestry crochet technique by working a few stitches over un-used color strands where it makes more sense to do than to add a new color bobbin, (usually when stitches just above are the same color). Be careful to keep all floats and/or un-used color strands on the wrong side of your work. Follow the color chart from the bottom up, right to left on Right Side rows and from left to right on Wrong Side rows.



Flower Power Wrap Continued

WRAP

With MC, ch 51.

Setup Row (WS): Hdc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, turn — 50 hdc.

Rows 1-87: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), hdc in each st across, changing bobbins according to the color chart, turn — 50 hdc.

Rep Rows 1-87 of color chart once then rep Rows 1-25 once, or to desired length.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block piece to finished measurements.

CC	contrast color
ch	chain
hdc	half double crochet
MC	main color
rep	repeat(ing)
WS	wrong side
