Hooded Pullover

Type : Knit

Hooded Pullover

Materials

Premier® Yarns *Stitch Please™ Superwash Worsted* (100% Superwash Wool; 3.5oz/100g, 220yds/200m)

- 2034-43 Hibiscus - 5 (6, 7, 8, 10) (11, 12, 13, 14) Balls

Needle

US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 24-32" circular needle and set of double pointed needles and US Size 6 (4 mm) 24-32" circular needle and set of dpns or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions

Tapestry needle, stitch marker, stitch holders or waste yarn

Sizes

XS (S, M, L, 1X) (2X, 3X, 4X, 5X)

Finished Measurements

Chest: 38¼ (41¾, 46¼, 49¾, 54¼) (57¾, 62¼, 65¾, 70¼)"

Length: 26¾ (27, 27¾, 28, 28¾) (29, 29¼, 29¼, 29¾)"

Gauge

18 sts x 24 rows = 4" in St st with larger needle
Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/Techniques used in pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- Knitting in the round.
- Picking up stitches.
- K2tog and ssk decreases.
- Kfb increases.
- Seaming.

Pattern Notes

This Pullover is worked from the top down in one piece. Once the body is complete, the sleeves are picked up and worked from the top down in the round. Finally, the hood is picked up and worked in one piece. This Pullover has an oversized fit, choose a size 8-10" larger than your chest (full bust) for a fit as modeled. Pocket is knit separately and sewn to Pullover.

Pattern Stitch Guide

1X1 Rib (even number of sts)

Row (Rnd) 1: *K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rep Row (Rnd) 1 for patt.



Hooded Pullover Continued

PULLOVER

Back

With larger circular needle, cast on 86 (94, 104, 114, 122) (130, 140, 148, 158) sts. Work even in St st, until Back meas 9½ (10, 10½, 11, 11½) (12, 12¼, 12¼, 12½)" from cast-on edge, end having just worked a WS row. Cut yarn and place sts on stitch holder or waste yarn.

Left Front

With larger circular needle and RS of Back facing, pick up and knit 28 (32, 36, 39, 45) (49, 52, 56, 62) sts along the top left cast-on edge of Back.

Next Row (WS): Purl.

Cont in St st for 4 more rows.

Shape Neck

Inc Row (RS): K1, kfb, knit to end — 1 st inc'd.

Next Row (WS): Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 5 more times — 5 sts inc'd, 34 (38, 42, 45, 51) (55, 58, 62, 68) sts.

Cut yarn and place sts on stitch holder or waste yarn.

Right Front

With larger circular needle and RS of Back facing, pick up and knit 28 (32, 36, 39, 45) (49, 52, 56, 62) sts along the top right cast-on edge of Back.

Next Row (WS): Purl.

Cont in St st for 4 more rows.

Shape Neck

Inc Row (RS): Knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 — 1 st inc'd.

Next Row (WS): Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 5 more times — 5 sts inc'd, 34 (38, 42, 45, 51) (55, 58, 62, 68) sts.

Join Fronts

Place Left Front sts on working needle. Work across Right Front, cast on 20 (20, 20, 22, 22, 22, 24, 24, 24) sts, work across Left Front - 86 (94, 104, 114, 122) (130, 140, 148, 158) sts.

Cont in St st until Front meas 9½ (10, 10½, 11, 11½) (12, 12¼, 12¼, 12½)" from cast-on edge,

end having just worked a WS row.

Join Front and Back

Place Back on working needle with Front. Knit across Front and Back, pm and join to work in the rnd. Cont in St st in the rnd until piece meas 14" from Front and Back join, end having just worked a WS row. Switch to smaller needle. Work 3" even in **1X1 Rib**. Loosely bind off all sts in rib.

Sleeves

With larger dpns and RS facing, pick up and knit 86 (90, 94, 100, 104) (108, 110, 110, 114) sts around armhole opening, pm and join to work in the rnd. Knit 2 rnds.

Dec Rnd: K1, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 — 2 sts dec'd.

All other rnds: Knit.

Rep Dec Rnd every 6th rnd 14 (12, 8, 2, 0, 0, 0, 0, 0) more times, every 4th rnd 5 (8, 14, 23, 26) (25, 24, 24, 23) times and then every other rnd 0 (0, 0, 0, 1) (3, 5, 5, 7) times — 38 (40, 44, 50, 54) (56, 58, 58, 60) sts dec'd, 46 (48, 48, 48, 48) (50, 50, 50, 52) sts rem.

Work 2 rnds even in patt. Switch to smaller dpns and work 2" even in **1X1 Rib**. Loosely bind off all sts in rib. Rep for other Sleeve.

FINISHING

Hood

With larger dpns, beg at the center front, pick up and knit 70 (70, 70, 74, 74) (74, 78, 78, 78) sts around neck opening, pm and join for working in the rnd. Knit 2 rnds.

Switch to larger circular needle and begin working in rows, starting st the center front m.

Next Row (WS): P35 (35, 35, 37, 37) (37, 39, 39, 39), pm, p to end.

Inc Row (RS): Knit to 3 sts bef m, kfb, k1, sm, k1, kfb, knit to end — 2 sts inc'd.

All other rows: Work even in St st.

Rep Inc Row every RS row once more and then every other RS row 5 times — 12 sts inc'd, 84 (84, 84, 88, 88) (88, 92, 92, 92) sts total.

Work even in St st until Hood meas 11¾ (11¾,

11¾, 12¼, 12¼) (12¼, 13, 13, 13)“ from neck pick up.

Dec Row 1 (RS): Knit to 3 sts bef m, ssk, k1, sm, k1, k2tog, knit to end — 2 sts dec'd.

All other rows: Work even in patt.

Work 3 rows even in patt, then rep Dec Row 1 every RS row 4 times — 8 sts dec'd.

Dec Row 2 (RS): Knit to 5 sts bef m, [ssk] twice, k1, sm, k1, [k2tog] twice, knit to end — 4 sts dec'd.

All other rows: Work even in patt.

Rep Dec Row 2 every RS row 3 more times — 12 sts dec'd.

Dec Row 3 (RS): Knit to 6 sts bef m, ssk, sk2p, k1, sm, k1, k3tog, k2tog, knit to end — 6 sts dec'd, 52 (52, 52, 56, 56) (56, 60, 60, 60) sts rem. Fold Hood RS together and finish with three-needle bind off.

Hood Edging

With smaller dpns and RS facing, pick up and knit 106 (106, 106, 112, 112) (112, 118, 118, 118) sts (approximately 3 sts to every 4 rows) around the Hood opening, pm and join for working in the rnd. Work 2“ even in **1X1 Rib**. Loosely bind off all sts in rib.

Kangaroo Pocket

With larger needle, cast on 70 (76, 84, 90, 98) (104, 112, 120, 128) sts.

Work 8 rows even in St st.

Bind off 4 sts at the beg of the next 2 rows – 8 sts dec'd, 62 (68, 76, 82, 90) (96, 104, 112, 120) sts rem.

Bind off 2 sts at the beg of the next 2 rows – 4 sts dec'd, 58 (64, 72, 78, 86) (92, 100, 108, 116) sts rem.

Dec Row (RS): K1, ssk, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 2 sts dec'd.

Next Row (WS): Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 11 more times – 34 (40, 48, 54, 62) (68, 76, 84, 92) sts rem.

Work 8 rows even in St st, loosely bind off all sts.

With RS facing and smaller needle, pick up and knit 30 sts along curved edge of Pocket (do not pick up along the first 8 rows of Pocket, these

will be sewn to Body of Pullover. Work 1“ even in 1X1 Rib. Loosely bind off all sts in rib. Rep for other side.

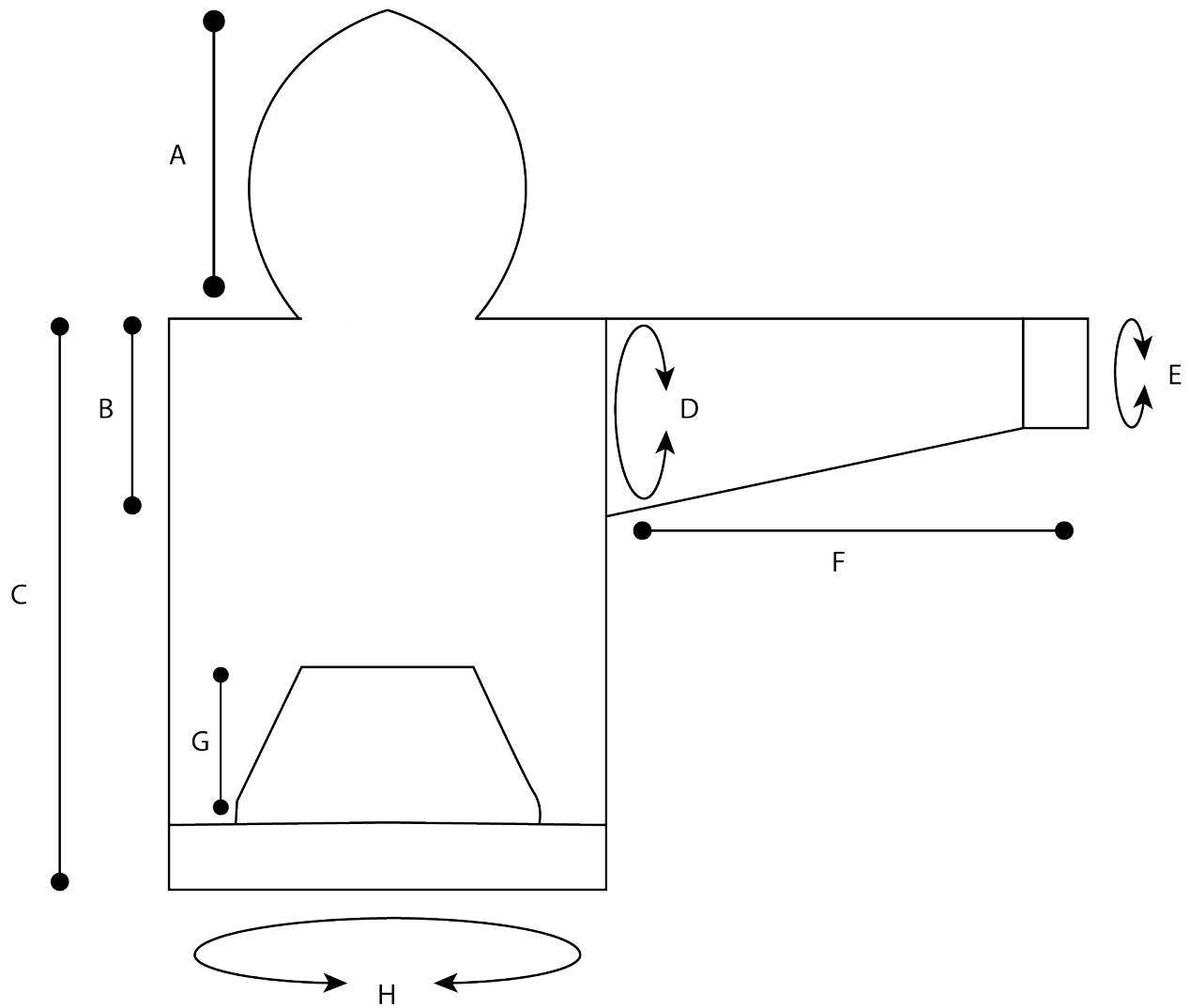
Center Pocket on the front of Pullover, with bottom cast-on edge aligned with the top of the bottom ribbing. Sew to Pullover along bottom cast-on edge of Pocket, the straight vertical edge on each side and the top bound off edge.

Weave in ends.

- B. 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ (10, 10 $\frac{3}{4}$, 11, 11 $\frac{3}{4}$) (12, 12 $\frac{1}{4}$, 12 $\frac{1}{4}$, 12 $\frac{3}{4}$)"
- C. 26 $\frac{3}{4}$ (27, 27 $\frac{3}{4}$, 28, 28 $\frac{3}{4}$) (29, 29 $\frac{1}{4}$, 29 $\frac{1}{4}$, 29 $\frac{3}{4}$)"
- D. 19 (20, 20 $\frac{3}{4}$, 22 $\frac{1}{4}$, 23) (24, 24 $\frac{1}{2}$, 20 $\frac{1}{2}$, 20 $\frac{1}{2}$)"
