Type: Crochet

Chevron Cuff Pullover

Materials

Premier® Yarns Stitch Please™ Worsted (100% Wool; 3.5oz/100g, 220yds/200m)

- MC: 1134 –29 Gray Area 4 (5, 5, 6, 6, 7, 7, 8, 8) hanks
- C1: 1134 –35 Achieve Grapeness 1 hank
- C2: 1134 53 Cactus Makes Perfect 1 hank

Hook

US Size H-8 (5 mm) and US 7 (4.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions

Tapestry needle, locking stitch markers

Sizes

XS (S, M, L, 1X) (2X, 3X, 4X, 5X) Shown in Size S

Finished Measurements

Bust Circumference: 35½ (40½, 44½, 48, 51½) (56½, 60½, 64, 67½)"

Length: 231/4 (241/4, 251/4, 261/4, 271/4) (281/4, 291/4, 301/4, 311/4)"

Gauge

13 dc x 7 rows = 4" with larger hook 17 blo sc x 16 rows = 4" with smaller hook Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/Techniques used in pattern:

- Chain, single, and double crochet stitches.
- Changing colors.
- Seaming panels together.
- Working through the back loops of stitches.

Pattern Notes

This Pullover is worked from the bottom up in pieces then seamed.

Pattern Stitch Guide

Ribbing Pattern (any number of sts)

Setup Row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and

each ch across, turn.

Row 1: Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), working in back loops only, sc in each sc across, turn. Rep Row 1 for pattern.



Chevron Cuff Pullover Continued

PULLOVER

Front/Back

With MC and smaller hook, ch 9. Work in **Ribbing Pattern** until piece measures 17¾ (20¼, 22¼, 24, 25¾) (28¼, 30¼, 32, 33¾)". Do not fasten off. Rotate piece and begin working into row ends.

Body

Setup Row: With larger hook, ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), evenly space 57 (65, 71, 77, 83) (91, 97, 103, 109) dc across row ends, turn — 58 (66, 72, 78, 84) (92, 98, 104, 110) dc.

Row 1: Ch 3, dc in each dc across, turn — 58 (66, 72, 78, 84) (92, 98, 104, 110) dc. Rep Row 1 until piece measures 19 (20, 21, 22, 23) (24, 25, 26, 27)" from edge of Ribbing. Do not fasten off.

Shape Neck

First Side

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3, dc in next 17 (21, 23, 26, 29) (32, 34, 37, 40) sts, leave rem sts unworked, turn — 18 (22, 24, 27, 30) (33, 35, 38, 41) dc.

Rows 2-4: Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn — 18 (22, 24, 27, 30) (33, 35, 38, 41) dc. Fasten off.

Second Side

With RS facing, sk center 22 (22, 24, 24, 24) (26, 28, 28, 28) dc and join MC in next st with a sl st. **Row 1 (RS):** Ch 3, dc in each rem st across, turn — 18 (22, 24, 27, 30) (33, 35, 38, 41) dc.

Rows 2-4: Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn — 18 (22, 24, 27, 30) (33, 35, 38, 41) dc. Fasten off.

Sleeves

Chevron Cuff

With C1 and larger hook, ch 37 (37, 37, 37, 48) (48, 48, 59, 59).

Setup Row: 2 dc in 4th ch from hook, (first 3 skipped chs count as dc), *dc in next 4 ch, sk next 2 ch, dc in next 4 ch, 3 dc in next ch; rep from * across, turn — 36 (36, 36, 36, 47) (47, 47, 58, 58) dc.

Row 1: With C2, ch 3, dc in same st, dc in next 5 sts, *sk next 2 sts, dc in next 4 sts**, 3 dc in next st, dc in next 4 sts; rep from * to last 2 sts, ending last rep at **, dc in next st, 2 dc in last st, turn.

Row 2: With C1, rep Row 1.

Rows 3-10: Rep Rows 1-2 four more times. Fasten off C1 and C2.

Main Sleeve

Row 1 (Inc Row): With MC, ch 3, 2 dc in next st, dc across to last 2 sts, 2 dc in next st, dc in last st, turn – 2 dc inc'd, 38 (38, 38, 38, 49) (49, 49, 60, 60) dc.

Rows 2-6 (9, 17, 19, 11) (17, 16, 15, 17): Rep Inc Row every 5 (4, 4, 3, 5) (4, 3, 2, 2) rows, 1 (2, 4, 6, 2) (4, 5, 7, 8) time(s) – 2 (4, 8, 12, 4) (8, 10, 14, 16) inc'd, 40 (42, 46, 50, 53) (57, 59, 63, 65) dc.

Rows 7 (10, 18, 20, 12) (18, 17, 16, 18) – 22 (22, 23, 23, 21) (21, 20, 20, 19): Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn.

FINISHING

Wash and block Front, Back and Sleeves. Sew shoulder seams, place locking marker at the top center of each Sleeve. Use marker to align center of Sleeve with shoulder seam, sew Sleeves along the edge of Front and Back. Sew Sleeve and side seams.

Neck Edging

Sleeve and side seams.

With MC and smaller hook, ch 6. Work in **Ribbing Pattern** until Neckband measures length to fit around neck edge, when slightly stretched. Beginning at left shoulder, sew Neckband in place around entire neck opening, end by sewing Neckband and left shoulder seams. Place locking stitch marker at the top center of each Sleeve. Use marker to align center of Sleeve with shoulder seam, sew Sleeves along the edge of Front and Back. Sew




