Lace Columns Pullover

Materials

Premier® Yarns *Stitch Please™* Worsted (100% Wool; 3.5oz/100g, 220yds/200m)

- 1134-02 Stay Gold - 5 (6, 6, 7, 7, 8, 8, 9, 9) skeins

Needles

US Size 7 (4.5 mm) straight needles

US Size 6 (4 mm) straight needles and 16" circular needle or set of dpns, *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions

Tapestry Needle

Stitch Holder or Waste Yarn

Locking Stitch Marker

Sizes

XS (Small, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X, 4X, 5X)

Finished Measurements

Bust: 34¼ (38¾, 42¼, 47, 50¾, 54¼, 58¼, 62¾, 66¾)"

Length: 24 (24¾, 25, 25¾, 26, 26¾, 27, 27, 27¼)"

Gauge

18 sts x 24 rows = 4" in St st

Save time, check your gauge.

Pattern Notes

This Pullover is worked in pieces and seamed. The neckband is picked up and worked in the round after the Pullover is seamed. For a fit as shown, choose a size 4-6" larger than full bust measurement.

Pattern Stitch Guide

Lace Columns (*multiple of 25 sts*)

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Rows 2 and 4 (WS): Purl.

Row 3: *K7, [k2tog] twice, [yo, k1] 3 times, yo, [ssk] twice, k7; rep from * to end.

Rep Rows 1-4 for patt.

2X2 Rib (*multiple of 4 sts*)

Row (Rnd) 1: *K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rep Row (Rnd) 1 for patt.

Lace Columns Pullover

Pullover Instructions

Back

With smaller needle, cast on 80 (88, 96, 108, 116, 124, 132, 144, 152) sts, work 3" even in **2X2 Rib**.

Sizes S (M, 3X) ONLY: Increase one st on the last row of rib — 89 (97, 133) sts.

Sizes XS and 4X ONLY: Decrease one st on last row of rib — 79 (143) sts.

All Sizes: Switch to larger needle.

Set Up Row 1 (RS): K2 (7, 11, 4, 8, 12, 4, 9, 1), work **Lace Columns** patt (start with Row 3) to last 2 (7, 11, 4, 8, 12, 4, 9, 1) sts, k2 (7, 11, 4, 8, 12, 4, 9, 1).

Set Up Row 2 (WS): P2 (7, 11, 4, 8, 12, 4, 9, 1), work **Lace Columns** patt to last 2 (7, 11, 4, 8, 12, 4, 9, 1) sts, p2 (7, 11, 4, 8, 12, 4, 9, 1).

Cont in patt as est'd until Back meas 24 (24¾, 25, 25¾, 26, 26¾, 27, 27, 27¼)" from cast-on edge, end having just worked a WS Row 4. Bind off all sts.

Front

Work as for the Back until Front meas 20 (20¾, 21, 21¾, 21¼, 22, 22¼, 22¼, 22¾)" from cast-on edge, end having just worked a WS Row 4.

Shape Neck

Row 1 (RS): K35 (40, 44, 49, 53, 57, 60, 65, 69) (left shoulder sts), bind off 9 (9, 9, 10, 10, 10, 13, 13, 14) sts, knit to end, place left shoulder sts on stitch holder or waste yarn — 35 (40, 44, 49, 53, 57, 60, 65, 69) right shoulder sts rem.

Row 2 (WS): Purl.

*Note: When decreasing in **Lace Columns** patt, work sts in St st if there aren't enough sts to work both the decrease and corresponding increase in pattern.*

Dec Row (RS): K1, ssk, work in patt to end — 1 st dec'd.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep these 2 rows 9 more times — 9 sts dec'd, 25 (30, 34, 39, 43, 47, 50, 55, 59) sts rem.

Work 4 (4, 4, 4, 8, 8, 8, 8, 8) rows even in patt, bind off sts.

Place held left shoulder sts on working needle and with WS facing, join working yarn.

Next Row (WS): Purl.

Dec Row (RS): Work in patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1— 1 st dec'd.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep the last 2 rows 9 more times — 9 sts dec'd, 25 (30, 34, 39, 43, 47, 50, 55, 59) sts rem.

Work 4 (4, 4, 4, 8, 8, 8, 8, 8) rows even in patt, bind off sts.

Sleeves (Make 2)

With smaller needle, cast on 40 (44, 44, 44, 48, 48, 48, 48) sts. Work 2" even in **2X2 Rib**, increase one st on the last row of rib — 41 (45, 45, 45, 49, 49, 49, 49) sts.

Switch to larger needle.

Set Up Row 1 (RS): K8 (10, 10, 10, 12, 12, 12, 12, 12), work **Lace Columns** patt to last 8 (10, 10, 10, 12, 12, 12, 12, 12) sts, k8 (10, 10, 10, 12, 12, 12, 12, 12).

Set Up Row 2 (WS): P8 (10, 10, 10, 12, 12, 12, 12, 12), work **Lace Columns** patt to last 8 (10, 10, 10, 12, 12, 12, 12, 12) sts, P8 (10, 10, 10, 12, 12, 12, 12, 12), Cont in patt as est'd for 12 (12, 8, 6, 6, 4, 0, 0, 0) more rows.

Shape Sleeve

Inc Row (RS): K1, kfb, work even in patt to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 — 2 sts inc'd.

All other rows: Work even in patt.

Rep Inc Row every 4th row 0 (2, 3, 11, 11, 19, 20, 20, 26) more times, and then every 6th row 15 (14, 14, 9, 9, 4, 4, 4, 0) times — 30 (32, 34, 40, 40, 46, 48, 48, 52) sts inc'd, 73 (79, 81, 87, 91, 97, 99, 99, 103) sts total.

Work even until Sleeve meas 21" from cast-on edge, end having worked a WS Row 2. Bind off all sts.

Finishing

Sew shoulder seams, place locking marker at the top center of each Sleeve. Use marker to align center of Sleeve with shoulder seam, sew Sleeves along the edge of Front and Back. Seam the Front and Back and Sleeves.

Neck Edging

With circ or dpns, pick up and knit 84 (84, 84, 88, 92, 92, 100, 100, 104) sts, pm and join to work in the rnd. Work even in **2X2 Rib** until edging meas 1", bind off all sts in rib.

Weave in ends.
