

# Stitch Please™



## Mix & Match Hat & Mitts

Type : Knit

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## Materials

**Premier® Yarns** *Stitch Please™ Worsted* (100% Wool; 3.5 oz/100 g, 220 yds/201 m)

- MC: 1134-23 On the Rocks – 2 skeins
- CC: 1134-19 Encourage-mint – 1 skein

## Needle

US Size 8 (5 mm) 16" circular needle and/or set of dpns and US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 16" circular needle and/or set of dpns or size needed to obtain gauge

## Notions

Tapestry needle, stitch markers in 2 colors, waste yarn

## Sizes

**Hat:** Adult Small (Medium, Large)

**Mitts:** Adult Small (Medium, Large)

## Finished Measurements

### Hat

**Circumference:** 18¾ (20, 21¼)"

**Height:** 11"

### Mitts

**Circumference:** 6¾ (7½, 8½)"

**Length:** 7½ (8, 9)"

## Gauge

18 sts x 24 rows = 4" in St st with larger needle  
Save time, check your gauge.

## Skills/Techniques used in pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- Knitting in the round.
- Changing colors.
- M1R and m1L increases.
- K2tog decreases.

## Pattern Notes

The Hat is worked from the bottom up in the round with multiple options. The Mitts are worked from wrist to fingers in the round with a gusseted thumb.

## Pattern Stitch Guide

**Twisted 1x1 Rib** (even number of sts)

**Row (Rnd) 1:** \*K1 tbl, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.



## Mix & Match Hat & Mitts Continued

**Stripe Pattern** (any number of sts)

**Rnds 1-6:** With MC, knit.

**Rnds 7-8:** With CC, knit.

Rep Rnds 1-8 for patt.

### HAT

With smaller needle and MC, cast on 84 (90, 96) sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work even in **1x1 Twisted Rib** for 2". Switch to larger needle, work **Stripe Pattern** (beg with Rnd 1) until Hat meas approximately 9½" from cast-on edge.

### Crown Shaping

*If working with circular needles, switch to dpns when stitches no longer fit comfortably on needles, continue in **Stripe Pattern**.*

**Rnd 1:** \*K4, k2tog; rep from \* to end – 14 (15, 16) sts dec'd.

**Rnds 2, 4 and 6:** Knit.

**Rnd 3:** \*K3, k2tog; rep from \* to end – 14 (15, 16) sts dec'd.

**Rnd 5:** \*K2, k2tog; rep from \* to end – 14 (15, 16) sts dec'd.

**Rnd 7:** \*K1, k2tog; rep from \* to end – 14 (15, 16) sts dec'd.

**Rnd 8:** \*K2tog; rep from \* to end – 14 (15, 16) sts dec'd.

**Rnd 9:** K0 (1, 0), \*k2tog; rep from \* to end – 7 (7, 8) sts dec'd, 7 (8, 8) sts rem.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail, thread tail onto tapestry needle and draw through remaining sts.

### MITTS

*Note: You may find it helpful to use different color markers to indicate the beg/end of rnd and the thumb gusset.*

#### Both Mitts

##### Cuffs

With smaller dpns and MC cast on 30 (34, 38) sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Work even in **1x1 Twisted Rib** until piece meas 2" from cast-on edge or to desired length.

Switch to larger dpns.

### Right Mitt

**Setup Rnd 1:** Work even in **Stripe Pattern** (beg with Rnd 1).

**Setup Rnd 2:** Work 17 (19, 21) sts in patt, pm, m1 (thumb gusset), pm, work in patt to end.

### Left Mitten

**Setup Rnd 1:** Work even in **Stripe Pattern** (beg with Rnd 1).

**Setup Rnd 2:** Work 13 (15, 17) sts in patt, pm, m1 (thumb gusset), pm, work in patt to end.

### Both Mittens

#### Thumb Gusset

Work one rnd even in patt.

**Inc Rnd:** Work in est'd patt to 1st thumb gusset marker, sm, M1L, knit to marker, M1R, sm, work in patt to end – 2 sts inc'd.

Work 2 rnds even in patt.

Rep last 3 rnds 5 (6, 7) more times – 43 (49, 55) sts.

**Gusset Separation Rnd:** Work in est'd patt to 1st thumb gusset marker, remove marker, sl next 13 (15, 17) sts to waste yarn for thumb, cast on 2 sts to bridge the gap, work in patt to end – 32 (36, 40) sts.

**Next Rnd:** Work in patt to 1 st before cast on sts, ssk, k2tog, knit to end – 30 (34, 38) sts. Work even in patt until piece meas 6½ (7, 8)" from cast-on edge.

#### Edging

Switch to smaller dpns and MC, work 1" even in **1x1 Twisted Rib**. Bind off sts in rib.

#### Thumb

Return 13 (15, 17) held thumb sts to larger dpns and join MC.

**Rnd 1:** Knit to end, pick up and knit 2 sts at cast on edge of thumb opening – 15 (17, 19) sts.

**Rnd 2:** Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, ssk last st of rnd with 1st st of next rnd – 13 (15, 17) sts.

Work 4 rnds even in St st. Bind off all sts.

## Mix & Match Hat & Mitts Continued

### FINISHING

Weave in ends. Wash and block, if desired.

### Abbreviations

<b>CC</b>	contrast color
<b>cont</b>	continue
<b>dec('d)</b>	decreased
<b>dpn(s)</b>	double point needle(s)
<b>est'd</b>	established
<b>inc('d)</b>	increase(d)
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
<b>meas</b>	measures
<b>MC</b>	main color
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>pm</b>	place marker
<b>rep</b>	repeat(ing)
<b>rnd(s)</b>	round(s)
<b>ssk</b>	slip slip knit (1 st dec'd)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>St st</b>	Stockinette stitch: knit every rnd.
<b>tbl</b>	through the back loop
