Materials

Premier® Yarns Stitch Please™ Worsted (100% Wool; 3.5oz/100g, 220yds/200m)

- 1134-02 Stay Gold 1 skein
- 1134-22 Whoopsie Daisy 1 skein
- 1134-29 Gray Area 1 skein

Notions

14" Wooden Embroidery Hoop

Pattern Stitch Guide

Lark's Head Knot: Fold length of yarn in half, place fold under hoop, and pull ends through loop. Knot should be snug against the hoop. Half Hitch Knot: Secure the yarn ends around the hoop by bringing them around the hoop, bringing the ends over and under itself, around the hoop, pulling to tighten.

Instructions

Cut 40, 80" pieces of yarn in Color A and Color B, fold each piece in half. Cut 6, 80" pieces of yarn in Color C.

Beginning anywhere on the inside hoop, attach all of color A with **Lark's Head Knots** (1-2). Working on the opposite side of the **Lark's Head Knot**, tie **Half Hitch Knots** to secure the yarn, pulling snug, but not too tight. (3)

Approximately 4" from Color A, begin to attach Color B with **Lark's Head Knots** (4-5).

Weave the first pair of ends of Color B over the first pair of ends of Color A, and under all remaining ends. Tie a **Half Hitch Knot** to secure to opposite side of hoop (6). Weave the second pair of ends of Color B over the first two pairs of Color A, and under all remaining Color A. Continue in this manner until all of Color B has been woven and tied off (7).

Attach Color C in the center of Color A and B (8). Weave the right two pairs of Color C over and under Color A, 2 pairs (4 ends) at a time. Repeat on the left side. With the center pair, weave two ends on either side of center (9). Secure all ends of Color C with **Half Hitch Knots** (10).

Create a hanging loop: Cut 6 pieces of Color C, 20" long, braid holding yarn in 3 groups of 2, knot ends around the top center of the hoop (11). Make a tassel with Color C. Trim the ends at an angle and attach the tassel to the center (12).
