



SIZES:

PULLOVER

18 mos (2 yrs, 4 yrs)

HAT

Baby (Toddler)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Pullover Chest: 21 (23¼, 25½)''

Hat Circumference: 16 (17½)''

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Everyday® Baby (100% Anti-pilling Acrylic; 113gm/308 yds)

- #DNE101-04 Coral (A) 1 ball
- #DNE101-01 White (B) 1 ball
- #DNE101-05 Purple (C) 1 ball
or
- #DNE101-06 Green (A) 1 ball
- #DNE101-01 White (B) 1 ball
- #DNE101-13 Turquoise (C) 1 ball

Note: One ball of each color will make both the sweater and the hat.

Needles: US Size 6 (4 mm) circular needles 16'' and 24'' long and set of 4 double pointed needles *or size needed to obtain gauge.*

US size 4 (3.5mm) circular needles 16'' long

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, pompom maker

GAUGE

22 sts x 28 rows = 4'' in Stockinette St

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Garter Stitch in the round

Rnd 1: Purl.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Repeat Rnds 1 and 2 for pattern.

Garter Stitch in rows

Knit every row.

Stockinette Stitch in the round

Rnd 1: Knit.

Repeat Rnd 1 for pattern.

Stockinette Stitch in rows

Rnd 1 (RS): Knit.

Rnd 2 (WS): Purl.

Repeat Rnds 1 and 2 for pattern.

PATTERN NOTES

This pullover is worked in one piece from the neck down. It is worked in the round from the neck edge to under the arms, then the front, back and sleeves are knit separately. Do not cut yarn when changing colors in striped sections; simply carry the yarn along the wrong side of the work to the next spot where it's needed.

PULLOVER

Collar:

With smaller 16'' circular needle and A, cast on 86 (92, 92) sts. Pm for beginning of round and join to work in the round.

Work 7 rounds of Garter Stitch in the round (4 ridges).

Yoke:

Change to larger 16'' circular needle and B.

Rnd 1: * K1, m1L, k22 (25, 27), m1R, k1, pm, k1, m1L, k17 (17, 15), m1R, k1, pm; rep from * once more – 94 (100, 100) sts, 4 markers.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Change to C.

Rnd 3: * K1, m1L, knit to 1 st before marker, M1R, k1, slip marker; rep from * 3 more times – 8 sts increased.

Rnd 4: Knit.

Change to B.

Rnd 5: Rep Rnd 3.

Rnd 6: Rep Rnd 4.

Change to C.

Rep Rnds 3-6, 7 (7, 8) more times, changing to longer needle when the work begins to feel crowded, then work Rnds 3 and 4, 0 (1, 1) more time - 222 (236, 252) sts.

Striped Pullover and Hat Set

Level: Intermediate

Striped Pullover and Hat Set

project continued

Lower Front:

Continuing established sequence of 2 row stripes, knit 58 (63, 69) sts to marker for front. Place remaining sts on holder.

Work Stockinette Stitch in rows, continuing established stripe sequence, until piece measures approximately 5½ (6, 6½)" from division, ending with 2 rows of B.

Change to smaller circular needle and A.

Knit 8 rows.

Bind off.

Left Sleeve:

Rejoin yarn and, continuing established sequence of 2 row stripes, knit 53 (55, 57) sts to marker for Left Sleeve. Leave remaining sts on holder.

Work Stockinette Stitch in rows, and continue established stripe sequence.

Purl 1 WS row.

Next Row – Decrease Row (RS): K1, ssk, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 2 sts decreased.

Rep Decrease Row every 4th row 7 (8, 9) more times – 37 sts.

Work even until piece measures approximately 4½ (5, 6)" from division, ending with 2 rows of B.

Change to smaller circular needle and A.

Knit 8 rows.

Bind off.

Lower Back:

Rejoin yarn and, continuing established sequence of 2 row stripes, knit 58 (63, 69) sts to marker for back. Leave remaining sts on holder.

Work same as for Lower Front.

Right Sleeve:

Rejoin yarn and, continuing established sequence of 2 row stripes, knit rem 53 (55, 57) sts for Right Sleeve. Work same as for Left Sleeve.

Finishing

Sew side and sleeve seams.

Weave in ends. Block gently.

HAT

With smaller circular needle and A, cast on 88 (96) sts. PM and join to work in the round.

Work 7 rounds of Garter Stitch in the round (4 ridges).

Change to larger 16" circular needle and B.

Knit 2 rounds with B.

Knit 2 rounds with C.

Continuing in established 2 row stripe pattern, work Stockinette Stitch in the round until piece measures 4½ (5½)".

Shape crown

Continue established 2 row stripe pattern throughout crown shaping. Change to double pointed needles when sts no longer fit comfortably on circular needle.

Next Rnd: * K11 (12), pm; rep from * to end – 8 markers, including beginning of rnd marker.

Next Rnd – Decrease Rnd: * Knit to 2 sts before marker, k2tog; rep from * to end – 8 sts decreased.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Repeat last 2 rounds 9 (10) more times – 8 sts remain.

Cut yarn and use tapestry needle to draw tail through remaining sts. Pull tight and fasten off.

Finishing

Weave in ends.

With A, make pompom according to manufacturer's instructions that came with pompom maker. Sew pompom to top of hat.

Block gently.
