

Striped Stocking

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 17"

Circumference: 8"

**MATERIALS** 

Premier® Yarns Couture Jazz™ (81% acrylic,

19% polyamide; 100gm/16.5 yds)
• 26-02 Milk (A) – 2 balls

• 26-33 Celadon (B) – 1 ball

Needle: US Size 50 (25 mm) 32" circular needle

Needle: 03 312e 30 (23 mm) 32 - Circular needle

or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Sewing needle & matching thread

**GAUGE** 

6% sts x 9 rows = 8" in St st

**Exact Gauge is not critical for this project** 

**PATTERN NOTES** 

At the gauge worked for the sample the entire ball of color B is used. If you work at a looser

gauge a 2<sup>nd</sup> ball may be needed.

The cleanest way to join a new ball of yarn is to use a needle and thread to sew the two ends together. I tuck the end of the new ball of yarn inside the end of the old ball of yarn and quickly whipstitch them together. There is no need to be too fussy about it. I recommend sewing together both balls of color A together before beginning and winding them into 1 ball.

STOCKING

With A, cast on 18 sts.

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

**Row 2 (RS):** With B, k8, m1, k2, m1, k8 – 20 sts.

Row 3: With B, purl. Row 4: With A, knit Row 5: With A, purl

**Row 6:** With B, k11, sssk, turn, sl 1, p2, p3tog, turn, \*sl 1, k2, k2tog, turn, sl 1, p2, p2tog, turn; rep from \* 2 more times, sl 1, knit to end –

10 sts.

Row 7: With B, purl Row 8: With A, knit Row 9: With A, purl Row 10: With B, knit Row 11: With B, purl

**Rows 12-15:** Rep Rows 8-11

Cut B.

Rows 16-19: With A, knit.

Bind off leaving last st on needle.

Starting with final stitch, finger crochet 6 chains for hanging loop. Fasten off, leaving a 6' tail for seaming.

**FINISHING** 

The easiest way to sew with this yarn is to use your fingers to poke and pull the yarn between the stitches. Weave in ends, except for the long tail left from the hanging loop.

Using the long tail, sew hanging loop down to last st, sew back seam and beginning edge.

Weave in end.

Use a needle and thread to sew the ends in place on the inside of the stocking to keep them from popping out to the right side.

## **Abbreviations**

**c** knit

**k2tog** knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

m1 insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)

**p** purl

p2tog purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)p3tog purl 3 sts together (2 sts dec'd)

rep repeat(ing)
RS right side
sl slip

ssk slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)

ssk slip next 3 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (2 sts dec'd)

st(s) stitch(es)

**St st** Stockinette stitch: knit on RS rows, purl on WS

rows.

**WS** wrong side
