

Super Chunky Hat

Level: Easy



SIZES

Adult Medium

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Head Circumference: 21¼"

MATERIALS

Isaac Mizrahi® CRAFT™ Central Park by Premier® Yarns (59% acrylic, 23% wool, 18% polyamide; 100 g/55 yds)

- IM2013-06 Sheep Meadow –2 balls

Needle: US Size 17 (12.75 mm) knitting needles *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

GAUGE

7 ½ sts x 11 rows = 4" in St st

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH PATTERN

Rib Pattern (*Mulltiple of 4 sts + 2*)

Row 1 (RS): K2, * p2, k2; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS): P2, * k2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for patt.

Stockinette Stitch (*any number of sts*)

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 (WS): Purl.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for patt.

HAT

Cast on 42 sts.

Work 8 rows in Rib Pattern, ending with a WS row.

Work 9 rows in Stockinette Stitch, ending with a RS row.

Shape Crown:

Row 1 (WS): P1, * pm, p5; rep from * to last 6 sts, pm, p6.

Row 2 – Decrease Row (RS): * Knit to 2 sts before marker, k2tog; rep from * to last st, k1. - 8 sts dec.

Row 3 (WS): Purl.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 three more times. - 10 sts rem.

Break yarn, leaving a tail 18" long. Use tapestry needle to draw tail through remaining sts, removing markers. Pull tight. Continuing with tail and tapestry needle, sew seam of hat from crown to brim.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and lightly block.

Abbreviations

dec: decrease

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

p: purl

patt: pattern

pm: place marker

rem: remain(ing)

rep: repeat(ing)

st(s): stitch(es)
