



## Bias Plaid Wrap

### SIZE

One Size

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Length:** 70"

**Width:** 18¾"

### MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Sweet Roll® Bold (100% Acrylic; 7oz/200gm, 109yds/100m)

- 2120-04 Neon Pop – 5 balls

**Needle:** US Size 11 (8mm) 40" circular *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, US Size 11 (8mm) crochet hook

### GAUGE

10 sts x 14 rows = 4" in St st

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- M1R increases.
- K2tog decreases.
- Applied crochet, slip stitches.

### PATTERN NOTES

This bright and bold Wrap's plaid feature is created by slip stitch crochet added in the purl columns. The bias shaping is worked on right side rows.

### WRAP

#### Edging

Cast on 47 sts, work even in Garter st for 1".

### Body

**Row 1 (RS):** K3, m1r, \*k7, p1; rep from \* to last 12 sts, k7, k2tog, k3.

**Row 2 (WS):** K3, p8, \*k1, p7; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k4.

**Row 3:** K3, m1r, p1, \*k7, p1; rep from \* to last 11 sts, k6, k2tog, k3.

**Row 4:** K3, p7, \*k1, p7; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k1, p1, k3.

**Row 5:** K3, m1r, k1, p1, \*k7, p1; rep from \* to last 10 sts, k5, k2tog, k3.

**Row 6:** K3, p6, \*k1, p7; rep from \* to last 6 sts, k1, p2, k3.

**Row 7:** K3, m1r, k2, p1, \*k7, p1; rep from \* to last 9 sts, k4, k2tog, k3.

**Row 8:** K3, p5, \*k1, p7; rep from \* to last 7 sts, k1, p3, k3.

**Row 9:** K3, m1r, k3, p1, \*k7, p1; rep from \* to last 8 sts, k3, k2tog, k3.

**Row 10:** K3, p4, \*k1, p7; rep from \* to last 8 sts, k1, p4, k3.

**Row 11:** K3, m1r, k4, p1, \*k7, p1; rep from \* to last 7 sts, k2, k2tog, k3.

**Row 12:** K3, p3, \*k1, p7; rep from \* to last 9 sts, k1, p5, k3.

**Row 13:** K3, m1r, k5, p1, \*k7, p1; rep from \* to last 6 sts, k1, k2tog, k3.

**Row 14:** K3, p2, \*k1, p7; rep from \* to last 10 sts, k1, p6, k3.

**Row 15:** K3, m1r, k6, p1, \*k7, p1; rep from \* to last 5 sts, k2tog, k3.

**Row 16:** K3, p1, \*k1, p7; rep from \* to last 11 sts, k1, p7, k3.

Rep Rows 1-16 until piece meas 69" from cast-on edge, end having just worked a WS row.

#### Edging

Work even in Garter st for 1". Loosely bind off

## FINISHING

### Applied Crochet

Starting at either end with RS facing and yarn held in back, insert crochet hook from RS of work to WS, into first st of purl column and pull up a loop (leave a long tail for weaving in later), insert hook in next st and pull up another loop, pull second loop through first, 1 sl st made. Cont in this manner until the entire column is complete, fasten off by pulling end through last loop and leave a long tail for weaving in later. Rep for other purl columns.

Weave in ends.

dec('d)	decrease(d)
Garner st	Knit every row.
inc('d)	increase(d)
k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
meas	measures
m1R	make 1 stitch, right leaning (1 st inc'd)
patt	pattern
rep	repeat(ing)
RS	right side
sl st	slip stitch
st(s)	stitch(es)
St st	Stockinette stitch: knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows.
WS	wrong side
