



Fuchsia Stripes Cowl

SIZE

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 80"

Height: 14½"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Sweet Roll® Bold (100% Acrylic; 7oz/200gm, 109yds/100m)

- MC: 2120-02 Summertime – 3 balls
- CC: 2120-04 Neon Pop – 2 balls

Needle: US Size 11 (8mm) 40" circular *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker

GAUGE

10 sts x 14 rnds = 4" in pattern st

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Knitting in the round.
- Knit and purl stitches.
- Changing colors.
- Knitting into rounds below.
- Passing loops over stitches.

STITCH GUIDE

Fuchsia Stripes Pattern (*multiple of 4 sts*)

Setup Rnd: With CC, knit.

Rnds 1-3: With CC, knit.

Rnd 4: With MC, *k3, insert RHN into next st below in Rnd 1 and pull up a loop, k1, pass loop over last st; rep from * to end.

Rnds 5-7: With MC, knit.

Rnd 8: With CC, *k1, insert RHN into next st below in Rnd 5 and pull up a loop, k1, pass loop over last st, k2; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 1-8 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

This extra-roomy Cowl is worked in one piece in the round. Double wrap it and wear it as a hood or drape it around your neck, either way you'll be cozy and cool at the same time! To avoid an excess of ends to weave in during finishing, do not cut yarn when switching to next color. Carry the yarn up along the inside by dropping the color not in use and bringing up new color behind the strand of the color just worked, catch carried yarn every other row.

COWL

Edging

With MC, cast on 200 sts, pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Purl 4 rnds.

Body

Work even in **Fuchsia Stripes Pattern** until piece meas 13½" from cast-on edge, end having just worked a Rnd 3, cut CC.

Edging

With MC, purl 4 rnds. Loosely bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Wash and block to Finished Measurements if desired.

Abbreviations

CC	contrasting color
k	knit
MC	main color
meas	measures
patt	pattern
pm	place marker
rep	repeat(ing)
RHN	right hand needle
rnd(s)	round(s)
st(s)	stitch(es)
St st	Stockinette stitch: knit every rnd.



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
