



## Granny Grande Cowl

### SIZE

One

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Circumference:** 25½"

**Height:** 11¼"

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Sweet Roll® Bold** (100% Acrylic; 7 oz/200 g, 109 yds/100 m)

- 2120-02 Summertime – 1 ball

**Hook:** US Size L-11 (8 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

### GAUGE

8 sts x 6 rows = 4" in hdc

1 Granny Square = 8½"

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### Skills/techniques used in pattern:

- Half double crochet and chain stitches.
- Working in the round.
- Seaming.

### STITCH GUIDE

**Magic Ring:** Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

### Granny Square

Begin with **Magic Ring**.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 4 (counts as hdc + ch 2 here and throughout), \*3 hdc in ring, ch 2; rep from \* 2 more times, 2 hdc, join with sl st in second ch of beg ch-4.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 4, 3 hdc in same sp, ch 1, \*(3 hdc, ch 2, 3 hdc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1; rep from \* 2 more times, 2 hdc in same sp as beg hdc, join with sl st to in second ch of beg ch-4.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 4, 3 hdc in same sp, ch 1, 3 hdc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, \*(3 hdc, ch 2, 3 hdc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 hdc in ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* 2 more times, 2 hdc in same sp as beg hdc, join with sl st to in second ch of beg ch-4.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 4, 3 hdc in same sp, ch 1, (3 hdc in ch-1 sp, ch 1) 2 times, \*(3 hdc, ch 2, 3 hdc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 hdc in ch-1 sp, ch 1) 2 times; rep from \* 2 more times, 2 hdc in same sp as beg hdc, join with sl st to in second ch of beg ch-4.

Fasten off.

### PATTERN NOTES

This cowl is made up of three half double crochet granny squares. The squares are seamed together, and then an edging is added. You may wish to "cherry pick" colors to begin with for Granny Squares and Edgings as they please you.

### COWL

Make 3 **Granny Squares**. Sew sides of **Granny Squares** together to form a tube.

### Upper Edging

Join yarn with sl st to any right hand corner sp from a **Granny Square**.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, \*hdc in same sp, (hdc in each of next 3 hdc, hdc in ch-1 sp) 3 times, hdc in each of next 3 hdc, hdc in corner sp; rep from \* 2 more times, join with sl st to beg hdc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, hdc in each hdc around, join with sl st to beg hdc.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, loosely sl st in each hdc around. Fasten off.


## FINISHING
