

River Rock Shawl

SIZE

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Depth: 33" Wingspan: 80"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Sweet Roll™ DK* (100% Acrylic; 4.9 oz/140 g, 541 yds/495 m)

2005-01 River Rock – 2 cakes

Hook: US Size G-6 (4 mm) hook or size needed

to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

19 sts x 8 rows = 4" in patt **Save time, check your gauge.**

PATTERN NOTES

The shawl begins at the center back neck and grows out and down toward the lower edge.

SHAWL

Setup Row: Ch 6, (5 skipped chs counts as dc and ch 1 here and throughout), dc in 6th ch from hook, turn – 2 dc and 1 ch-1 sp. **Row 1:** Ch 6, dc in 5th ch from hook, ch 1, dc in next dc, [ch 1, sk 1 ch, dc in next ch] twice, turn – 5 dc and 4 ch-1 sps; 3 dc inc'd, 3 ch-1 sps inc'd.

Row 2: Ch 6, dc in 5th ch from hook, *ch 1, dc in next dc; rep from * across, ending with ch 1, (dc, ch 1, dc) in top of turning ch, turn – 3 dc inc'd, 3 ch-1 sps inc'd.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures 33" from starting point.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Wash and block to Finished Measurements, if desired.

dc double crochetinc('d) increase(d)patt patternrep repeat

sc single crochet

skskipsp(s)space(es)st(s)stitch(es)
