



Afghan Stitch Hat & Mitts

Level: Easy

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

SCARF

Width: 7¾"

Length: 60"

MITTS

Circumference: 7"

Height: 7"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Sweet Roll® Frostie
(100% Acrylic; 5oz/140g, 245yds/224m)

- 1119-02 Limeade – 2 balls (MC)

Premier® Yarns Basix™ (100% Acrylic;
7oz/200g, 359yds/328m)

- 1115-02 Light Gray – 1 ball (CC)

Needle: US Size 9 (5.5 mm) straight needles
and US Size 10 (6 mm) straight needles *or size
needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

14 sts x 28 rows = 4" in Afghan St with larger
needle

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

The Scarf is worked from end to end. The Mitts
are worked flat from end to end and then
seamed, leaving a hole for the thumbs.

STITCH GUIDE

Afghan Stitch (*multiple 12 + 3 sts*)

Row 1 (WS): With MC, knit.

Row 2 (RS): With CC, k1, ssk, *k9, s2kp; rep
from * to end, end last rep with k2tog, k1.

Row 3: With CC, k1, *p1, k4, [k1, yo, k1] in next
st, k4; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Rows 4 and 5: With MC, work as Rows 2 and 3.
Rep Rows 2-5 for patt.

SCARF

With MC and larger needles, cast on 27 sts.
Work even in **Afghan St** until Scarf meas 60"
or to desired length, end having just worked
a Row 3. Work Row 1 and then bind off all sts
with MC.

MITTS (Make 2)

With MC and smaller needles, cast on 27 sts.
Work even in **Afghan St** until Mitt meas 7"
or to desired length, end having just worked a
Row 3. Work Row 1 and then bind off all sts
with MC.

FINISHING

Sew Mitts 3" along sides, leave a 1" opening
for thumb and then sew the rem 3". Weave in
ends.

Abbreviations

CC	contrasting color
dec('d)	decrease(d)
Garner st	Knit every row.
k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
MC	main color
meas	measures
p	purl
patt	pattern
rem	remain(ing)
rep	repeat(ing)
RS	right side
s2kp	slip 2 sts tog as if to k, k1, pass both slipped sts over k st (2 sts dec'd)
ssk	slip slip knit (1 st dec'd)
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	wrong side
yo	yarn over



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
