

# Frostie Stripes Cowl

#### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Circumference: 28"

Depth: 21"

#### **MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Sweet Roll® Frostie (100% Acrylic; 5oz/140g, 245yds/224m)

1119-05 Slushie – 2 balls

Needle: US Size 10 (6 mm) 24" circular needle

or size needed to obtain gauge **Notions:** Tapestry needle

#### **GAUGE**

14 sts x 28 rows = 4" in Garter st **Save time, check your gauge.** 

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

This Cowl is worked flat and then seamed. Increases, decreases and working on the bias create the asymmetrical shape. The eyelets are worked on rows where the color changes. Light steam blocking allows the cowl to drape nicely and makes it easier to seam. All stitches are slipped purlwise.

#### STITCH GUIDE

Garter st: Knit every row.

#### **COWL**

Cast on 4 sts; if close to a color change, start at the beg of the next color.

#### Set Up

Row 1 (RS): K1, [kfb] twice, k1 - 2 sts inc'd.

Row 2 (WS): SI 1, knit to end.

Total 6 sts.

#### Part One

Note: For all Eyelet Rows, if there aren't enough sts to complete rep, work rem sts in **Garter st**. **Row 1 (RS):** K1, kfb, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 — 2 sts inc'd.

Row 2 (WS): SI 1, knit to end.

Work Rows 1-2, except for when the color of the yarn changes. Then at the beg of the next row, work **Eyelet Row** as follows:

**RS Eyelet Row:** K1, kfb, \*k2tog, yo; rep from \* to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 — 2 sts inc'd.

-OR-

WS Eyelet Row: Sl 1, k1, \*k2tog, yo; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

Rep Rows 1-2, working **Eyelet Rows** as necessary, 24 more times (50 rows total for this section) — 56 sts total.

#### **Part Two**

**Row 1 (RS):** Sl 1, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 - 1 st inc'd.

Row 2 (WS): SI 1, knit to end.

Work Rows 1-2, except for when the color of the yarn changes. Then at the beg of the next row, work **Evelet Row** as follows:

**RS Eyelet Row:** Sl 1, k1, \*k2tog, yo; rep from \* to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 — 1 st inc'd.

-OR-

WS Eyelet Row: Sl 1, k1, \*k2tog, yo; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

Rep Rows 1-2, working **Eyelet Rows** as necessary, 39 more times (80 rows total for this section) — 96 sts total.

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#### **Part Three**

**Row 1 (RS):** Sl 1, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 - 1 st dec'd.

Row 2 (WS): SI 1, knit to end.

Work Rows 1-2, except for when the color of the yarn changes. Then at the beg of the next row, work **Eyelet Row** as follows:

**RS Eyelet Row:** Sl 1, k1, \*k2tog, yo; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 - 1 st dec'd.

-OR-

**WS Eyelet Row:** Sl 1, k1, \*k2tog, yo; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

Rep Rows 1-2, working **Eyelet Rows** as necessary, 25 more times (52 rows total for this section) – 70 sts rem.

Loosely bind off all sts.

#### **FINISHING**

Wash or steam block to finished measurements, if desired. Seam the two short edges together, creating a loop with the point in the front. Weave in ends.

#### **Abbreviations**


beg begin(ning)dec('d) decrease(d)foll followsinc('d) increase(d)k knit

kfb knit into the front and back of the next st (1 st

inc'd)

**k2tog** knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

rem remain(ing)
rep repeat(ing)
RS right side
sl slip
st(s) stitch(es)
WS wrong side
yo yarn over
