



## Pop Rocks Scarf

### SIZE

One Size

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Width:** 10"

**Length:** 60"

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Sweet Roll® Frostie** (100% Acrylic; 5oz/140g, 245yds/224m)

- 1119-10 Lollipop – 3 balls

**Hook:** US Size H-8 (5 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

### GAUGE

14 sts x 10 rows = 4" in hdc

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### Skills/Techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain stitches
- Foundation half double crochet
- Half double crochet
- Bobble stitches
- Making and tying fringe

### STITCH GUIDE

**Alternating Bobbles** (*multiple of 10 sts*)

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 2 (does not count as a st throughout), \*hdc in next 9 sts, **bobble** in next st; rep from \* across, omitting last **bobble**, hdc in last st, turn – 190 hdc, 20 bobbles.

**Row 2 (WS):** Ch 2, hdc in each st across, turn – 210 hdc.

**Row 3:** Ch 2, hdc in next 4 sts, **bobble** in next st, \*hdc in next 9 sts, **bobble** in next st; rep from \* to last 5 sts, hdc in last 5 sts, turn.

**Row 4:** Rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 1-4 for patt.

**Bobble:** (Yo, insert hook in indicated st, yo and draw up a loop, yo draw through 2 loops) four times, yo, draw through 5 loops on hook.

**Fhdc (Foundation half double crochet):** Ch 3, yo, insert hook into 3 rd ch from hook, yo, pull up loop (3 loops on hook), yo, pull through 1 loop (1 ch made), yo, draw through all loops on hook (1 foundation half double crochet made). \*Yo, insert hook under the 2 loops of the chain at base of last st, pull up loop, yo, draw through 1 loop, yo, draw through all loops on hook; rep from \* to desired number of Fhdc.

### PATTERN NOTES

This scarf is worked flat lengthwise.

### SCARF

**Setup Row:** Fhdc 210, turn.

Work in **Alternating Bobbles** for 24 rows, or until width meas 10" ending having just worked a WS Row.

### FINISHING

#### Fringe

Cut 48 – 16" lengths of yarn in colors coordinating with stripes. Holding 2 lengths together as one, fold in half forming a loop on one end. Insert crochet hook into end of Scarf from back to front pull the looped end of fringe partially through the edge. Pass the loose ends through the loop being sure to keep ends even. Pull taut. Place one group of fringe in every other row end. Repeat for other end of Scarf. Weave in ends.

<b>yo</b>	yarn over
