



## SIZES

One Size (to fit 8-10 yrs)

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Neck Circumference:** 16"

**Length:** 24" measured from neck to center point

**Width:** 18" at widest point

## MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Sweet Roll™ Frostie**  
(100% Acrylic; 140g/245 yds)

- 1119-01 Sugar Plum – 2 balls

**Hook:** US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook  
*or size needed to obtain gauge.*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

14 sc x 16 rows = 4" in pattern stitch.

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## PONCHO

**Panel** (Make 2)

Ch 72.

**Setup Row:** Sc in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hk and in each ch across, ch 2, turn – 70 sc.

**Row 1:** Dc in each sc across, ch 1, turn – 70 dc.

**Row 2:** Sc in each dc across, ch 2, turn – 70 sc.

Rep Rows 1-2 until piece measures 13".

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew pieces together as shown in the diagram on the next page.

**Bottom Borders:** Attach yarn in front center point and sc 98 sts along the right-side edge of the front, around to the point in the back. Turn, and work back and forth in rows as follows:

**Row 1 (WS):** Sc flo the 98 border sts, ch 1, turn.

**Row 2 (RS):** Sc blo the 98 sts, ch 1, turn.

Rep Row 1. Fasten off.

Sc 101 sts along the other edge of the poncho and Rep Rows 1-3. Fasten off.

## Neck Edge:

Starting at the center back of neck, sc evenly around entire neck edge.

Work 3 rnds of sc flo. Fasten off.

Weave in all ends.

<b>ch</b>	chain
<b>dc</b>	double crochet
<b>flo</b>	front loop only
<b>hk</b>	hook
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>rnd(s)</b>	round(s)
<b>sc</b>	single crochet
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
