



## Hex Blanket

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Width:** 55"

**Length:** 55"

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Sweet Roll™ Fruits** (100% acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 174yds/160m)

- A: 2056-02 Dragonfruit – 7 balls
- B: 2056-06 Pink Grapefruit – 6 balls
- C: 2056-07 Lime – 6 balls

**Hook:** US Size G-6 (4 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers

### GAUGE

1 Hexagon = 13" across

17 sts x 20 rnds = 4" in single crochet

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain stitches, slip stitch, single crochet stitches.
- Working in the round.
- Seaming.

### PATTERN NOTES

Throw is made from 19 hexagons that are made individually and then sewn together.

### HEXAGON (make 7 in A, 6 each in B and C)

Ch 4, join with sl st to first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, sc in ring, (ch 2, sc in ring) 5 times, ch 2, join with sl st to beg sc – 6 sc, 6 ch-2 sps.

**Rnd 2:** Sl st to next ch-2 sp, ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) in same sp, (sc, ch 2, sc) in each ch-2 sps around, join with sl st to beg sc – 12 sc and 6 ch-2 sps.

**Rnd 3:** Sl st to next ch-2 sp, ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) in same sp, \*sc next st, sc in next st, (sc, ch 2, sc)

in next ch-2 sp; rep from \* around to last 2 sts, sk next st, sc in last st, join with sl st to beg sc – 24 sc, 6 ch-2 sps.

**Rnd 4:** Sl st to next ch-2 sp, ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) in same sp, \*sk next sc, sc in next 3 sts, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch-2 sp; rep from \* around to last 4 sc, sk next st, sc in next 3 sts, join with sl st to beg sc – 30 sc, 6 ch-2 sps.

**Rnd 5:** Sl st to next ch-2 sp, ch 1, (sc, ch 2, sc) in same sp, \*sk next st, sc in each st to next ch-2 sp, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch-2 sp; rep from \* around, ending sc in each st to end of rnd, join with sl st to beg sc – 36 sc, 6 ch-2 sps.

**Rnds 6-28:** Rep Rnd 5. At the end of Rnd 28, there are 29 sc along each side, 174 sc total, 6 ch-2 sps.

Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Block each Hexagon to Finished Measurements. With RS facing and A, following Diagram, sew Hexagons together. Weave in ends.

<b>ch</b>	chain
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>rnd(s)</b>	round(s)
<b>sc</b>	single crochet
<b>sp(s)</b>	space(es)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>sl st</b>	slip stitch
