



Sugarplum Poncho

SIZES

2-4T (5-7 yrs, 8-10 yrs)

Shown in 2-4yrs

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Neck Circumference: 14¾ (16, 17¼)"

Height: 16 (20, 24)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Sweet Roll® Fruits
(100% acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 174ds/160m)

- 2056-03 Plum – 3 (4, 5) cakes

Hook: US Size H-8 (5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

GAUGE

13 sts x 6 rows = 4" in dc

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain Stitches
- Double Crochet
- Foundation Single Crochet
- Picot

STITCH GUIDE

Foundation single crochet (fsc): Ch 2, insert hook in 2nd ch from hook, yo, pull up a lp (2 lps hook), yo, pull through 1 lp (1 ch made), yo, pull through 2 lps (fsc completed), *insert hook under the 2 lps of the ch at bottom of st just made, yo, pull up a lp, yo, pull through 1 lp, yo, pull through 2 lps; rep from * to desired number of fsc.

PATTERN NOTES

This Poncho is worked from the neck down in joined rounds without turning. Increases occur every round at two points to form a V-neck in the center front and center back. Join all rounds with a slip stitch.

PONCHO

Setup: Leaving a 10" tail, fsc 48 (52, 56), being careful not to twist, join last sc to first sc with a sl st.

Note: Use the tail to sew the bottom of the first fsc to the bottom of the last fsc to close the gap.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), *dc in next 23 (25, 27) sts, 3 dc in next st (pm in 2nd dc of 3-dc group made); rep from * once, join — 4 dc inc'd, 52 (56, 60) dc total.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, *dc in each st to marked st, 3 dc in marked st (move marker to center dc of 3-dc group just made); rep from * once, dc in each rem dc, join — 4 dc inc'd, 56 (60, 64) dc total.

Rnds 3 - 23 (29, 35): Rep Rnd 2 — 140 (168, 196) dc.

Rnd 24 (30, 36): Ch 3, dc in each st around — 140 (168, 196) dc.

Picot Rnd: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), sc in same st, sc in next 2 sts, *ch 3, sl st to 3rd ch from hook (picot made)**; sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around, ending last rep at **, join to beg sc.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
