



Granny Square Blanket

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 38"

Length: 38"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Sweet Roll™ Vivid
(100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 174yds/160m)

- 2100-07 Neon Signs – 6 cakes

Hook: US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, removable stitch markers

GAUGE

1 Granny Square = 6"

Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain stitches, slip stitch, single, double and half double crochet stitches.
- Working in back loop only.
- Working in joined rounds.
- Seaming.

PATTERN NOTES

The Granny Squares are worked separately, then crocheted together. They are worked in joined rounds, with right side always facing. Do not turn at beginning of rounds. The Border is worked all the way around the outside edges of joined squares.

BLANKET

Granny Square (make 36)

Ch 4, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 2, join with

sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 12 dc and 4 ch-2 sps.

Rnd 2: Sl st to ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp (first corner made), *ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp (corner made); rep from * 2 more times, ch 1, join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 24 dc, 4 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (6 dc and 1 ch-1 sp along each of 4 sides between ch-2 corner sps).

Rnd 3: Sl st to ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, *ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * 2 more times, ch 1, join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 36 dc, 8 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (9 dc and 2 ch-1 sps along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Rnd 4: Sl st to ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, *ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice; rep from * 2 more times, ch 1, join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 48 dc, 12 ch-1 sps, and 4 corner ch-2 sps (12 dc and 3 ch-1 sps along each of 4 sides between corner ch-2 sps).

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in each st and ch-1 sp around, working 3 sc in each corner ch-2 sp, join with sl st in first sc – 72 sc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Crochet edges of 6 squares in one row together, working each seam as follows: From RS, beginning at one end of edge and working in blo of both thicknesses, sl st along edge. Rep until all 6 squares are joined together to make a strip. Rep to make 6 total strips. Rep to join each side edges of strips together.

Border

From RS, join with sl st in any ch-2 corner sp of blanket.

Rnd 1 (RS): Working in blo, ch 1, sc in each st and ch-sp around outside edge of blanket, working 3 sc in each corner; join with sl st in first st.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, hdc in each st around, working 3 hdc in each center sc of each 3-sc corner, join with sl st to first st.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in each st around, working 3 sc in each center hdc of 3-hdc corner, join with sl st to first st.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
