

Star Blanket

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Diameter: 40"

## MATERIALS

Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns Sweet Roll ${ }^{\circledR}$ Vivid (100\% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 174yds/160m)

- 2100-06 It's Electric - 5 cakes

Hook: US Size I-9 ( 5.5 mm ) or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

$14 \mathrm{dc} \times 8$ rows $=4$ "
Save time, check your gauge.

## Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, single and double crochet stitches.
- Shell stitch.
- V-stitch.
- Working in joined rounds


## STITCH GUIDE

Shell: (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc ) in indicated st. V-stitch (V-st): (Dc, ch 2, dc) in indicated st.

## PATTERN NOTES

Blanket is worked in joined rounds. If you increase the size of blanket by increasing the rounds as instructed in pattern, you will need additional yarn.

## BLANKET

With A, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.
Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 10 dc in ring, join with sl st in top of beg ch-3-11 dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same st as joining sl st, 2 dc in each st around, join with sl st in top of beg ch-3-22dc.
Rnd 3: Ch 3, sk same st as joining sl st, *sk next st, V-st in next st; rep from * to last st, sk last st, dc in same st as joining sl st, ch 2, join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 (to join round and complete last V-st) - 11 V-sts. Rnd 4: SI st to ch-2 sp of next V-st, ch 3, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc ) in same ch-2 sp (first shell made), shell in ch-2 sp of each V-st around, join with sl st in top of beg ch-3-11 shells. Rnd 5: SI st in next st, ch 3 (counts as dc), *shell in next ch-2 sp, dc in next st, sk next 2 sts, dc in next st; rep from * to last ch-2 sp , shell in last ch-2 sp , dc in next st, sk last st, join with sl st in top of beg ch-311 shells and 22 dc ( 6 dc between ch- 2 sps ). Rnd 6: SI st to dc immediately following the ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next st, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, shell in next ch- $2 \mathrm{sp}, *$ dc in next 2 sts, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, shell in next ch-2 sp; rep from * around, join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 11 shells and 44 dc ( 4 dc along each side of 11 points).
Rnd 7: Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk next 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts, shell in next ch-2 sp, *dc in next 3 sts, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts, shell in next ch-2 sp; rep from * around, dc in last 2 sts, join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 - 11 shells and 66 dc ( 5 dc along each side of 11 points).
Rnd 8: SI st to ch-2 of next shell, ch 3, *dc in each st to 1 st before sp where 2 sts were skipped in previous rnd, sk next 2 sts, dc in each st to next ch-2 sp, shell in ch-2 sp; rep from * around, join with sl st in top of beg

## project continued

ch-3 - 11 shells and 88 dc ( 6 dc along each side of 11 points).
Rnd 9: Ch 3 (counts as dc), *dc in each st to 1 st before sp where 2 sts were skipped, sk next 2 sts, dc in each st to next ch-2 sp, shell in ch-2 sp; rep from * around, dc in last 2 sts, join with sl st in top of beg ch-3-11 shells and 110 dc ( 7 dc along each side of 11 points).
Rnds 10-19: Rep Rnds 8 and 9 until you have 19 dc along each side of 11 points.

## Option to increase size:

Continue to Rep Rnds 8 and 9 until desired size. Each Rnd will increase by 1 dc along each side and will continue to have 11 points. Work Last Rnd as written; stitch count will be different.

Last Rnd (Rnd 20): SI st to ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 1, *3 sc in same ch-2 sp, sc in each st to 1 st before sp where 2 sts were skipped, sk next 2 sts, sc in each st to next ch-2 sp; rep from * around, join with sl st in first sc - 429 sc (18 sc along each side of 3-sc points). Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Gently block.
Weave in ends.
