

Cascade Vest

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS** 

Length of Back: 20" Length of Drape: 27"

**Bust: 28"** 

MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns** *Sweet Roll®* (100% Acrylic; 5oz/140g, 245ds/224m)

• #1047-45 Blue Willow – 3 balls

**Hook:** US Size J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook *or size* 

needed to obtain gauge Notions: Tapestry needle

**GAUGE** 

10 sts x 10 rows = 4" in Third Loop Half Double Crochet

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

**Third Loop Half Double Crochet** (any number of sts + 2 for foundation ch)

Note: Rather than working into the stitch as you normally would, you will work into the 'third loop' of the half double crochet stitch. The horizontal line at the back of the stitch is the third loop. Working into this loop creates a unique, ribbing effect.

**Varied Rib Pattern** (any odd number + 2 for foundation ch)

**Set Up Row (RS):** Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch to end, turn.

**Row 1:** Ch 2 (does not count as st here and throughout), Third Loop Half Double Crochet in each st to end, turn.

Rows 2 & 4: Ch 2, hdc in each st to end, turn. Row 3: Ch 2, hdc flo in each st to end, turn.

Rep Rows 2-4 for Patt

Front Panel (Make 2)

Ch 49.

Work **Varied Rib Pattern** until piece measures approximately 20", ending having just worked

Row 2 or 4. Fasten off.

Back (Make 1)

Ch 39.

Work **Varied Rib Pattern** until piece measures approximately 20", ending having just worked Row 2 or 4.

**Shoulder Seaming** 

Sew top edge of each Front Panel edge to the back by sewing one front to each side of the back to form shoulders. Each shoulder seam should be approx. 4", leaving approx. 7.5" open at the center of the Back Panel for the neck.

**Side Seaming** 

Sew the fronts to the back along the sides, leaving an opening 8" long for the armholes.

**FINISHING** 

Weave in any remaining ends.

**Abbreviations** 

ch chain

flo front loop only hdc half double crochet

patt pattern
rep repeat(ing)
st(s) stitch(es)
