

Honeycomb Knit Cowl

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 13"

Circumference: 32" lightly blocked

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Sweet Roll® (100% acrylic; 140 gm/245 yds)

• #1047-42 Rock Candy – 1 ball

Needle: US Size 7 (4.5 mm), US Size 8 (5.0 mm) 24" circular knitting needles, or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch marker, cable

needle

GAUGE

17 sts x 17 rows = 4" in Honeycomb Pattern **Save time, check your gauge.**

STITCH GUIDE

Honeycomb Pattern

Rnd 1: *C4B, C4F, rep from * to marker.

Rnds 2-4: Knit.

Rnd 5: *C4F, C4B, rep from * to marker.

Rnds 6-8: Knit.

C4B (Cable 4 sts back): slip next 2 sts to cable needle, hold needle in back of work, knit 2 sts from left-hand needle, then knit 2 sts from cable needle

C4F (Cable 4 sts front): slip next 2 sts to cable needle, hold needle in front of work, knit 2 sts from left-hand needle, then knit 2 sts from cable needle

COWL (multiple of 8 sts)

Note: CO multiples of 8 sts for longer cowl.
CO 136 sts. Place marker and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.
Rnd 1: *K2, p2; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rep Rnd 1 until rib measures 1.5".

Knit 1 rnd.

Work the **Honeycomb Pattern** 5 times.

Work K2, P2 Rib as on the opposite side for 1.5".

Loosely bind off all sts in rib.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

k knitp purl

pm place marker
rnd(s) round(s)
rep repeat(ing)
st(s) stitch(es)
