



## Macaron Cowl

Level: Intermediate

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Circumference:** 42"

**Width:** 9 ½"

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Sweet Roll®** (100% Acrylic, 140g/245yds)

- #1047-44 Honey Lavender – 1 ball

**Hook:** US Size I (5.5 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch marker

### GAUGE

12 dc x 6 rows= 4" in pattern

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### PATTERN NOTES

Cowl will be worked in a spiral. Place marker to indicate starting st on each rnd.

### STITCH GUIDE

**Crossed Double Crochet (CRDC):** Sk 1 st, dc in next st, dc in st you just sk'd. *Use 2 new sts each time, making sure not to work into the stitches already used.*

### COWL

Ch 120. Join with a sl st, being careful not to twist the chain, ch 2, pm.

Work 2 rnds of dc, moving marker up as you finish each rnd.

Skipping the first dc after the marker, begin rnds of **CRDC**.

Work rnds of **CRDC** until the piece measures 8 ½".

Work 2 rnds of dc.

Sl st together over next 3 sts to smooth out the joining sts.

### FINISHING

Weave in all ends.

<b>ch</b>	chain
<b>dc</b>	double crochet
<b>rnd(s)</b>	round(s)
<b>sk</b>	skip
<b>sl st</b>	slip stitch
