



# Drop Stitch Scarf

### **Drop Stitch Scarf**



#### TYPE: Knit DESIGNER: Premier® Yarns Design Team

#### SIZES:

One Size

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS: Width: 91/4"

Length: 60"

#### GAUGE:

18 sts x 36 rows = 4" in Garter st with C1 and C2 held together **Save time, check your gauge.** 

#### MATERIALS:

**Premier® Yarns** *Trinket*<sup>™</sup> (75% Acrylic, 25% Nylon; 1.76oz/50g, 437yds/400m)

- C1: 2161-07 Jade 1 ball
  Premier<sup>®</sup> Yarns Gala<sup>™</sup> (95% Polyester, 5% Metallic Polyester; 1.76oz/50g, 149yds/137m)
- C2: 2085-03 Green 2 balls

#### **NEEDLES & NOTIONS:**

- US Size 8 (5 mm) straight or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

#### SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- Double wrapping stitches.
- Dropping stitches.

#### PATTERN NOTES

Trinket is a fun carry-along yarn that has colorful tweedy nubs to give your project a complex and interesting effect! Gala is also a special yarn that can be used alone or together with other yarns. Trinket and Gala are held together for the garter sections in this Scarf, while Trinket is used alone for the drop-stitch sections. Carry Gala loosely up the side of the work during the Trinket-only sections.

#### SCARF

With both yarns held together, cast on 42 sts.

Rows 1-9: With both yarns held together, knit.

**Row 10:** With C1 only, knit the first st, wrapping the yarn twice around the needle, \*knit the next st, wrapping the yarn twice around the needle; rep from \* to end – 84 sts on needle.

**Row 11:** With C1 only, knit the first st, dropping the extra wrap off the needle, \*knit the next st, dropping the extra wrap off the needle; rep from \* to end – 42 sts rem.

Rep Rows 1-11 until Scarf measures 60" from cast-on edge, ending after having just worked a Row 9.

Bind off all sts using both yarns.

#### FINISHING

Weave in ends and block lightly.
