Two Faced Cowl

Level: Intermediate

# **Finished Measurements:**

Circumference: 34"

Width: 6"

Premier® Yarns Everyday® Soft Worsted Heathers (100% Acrylic; 100 gm; 180 yd)

1 skein DN110-07 Cocoa Heather (A)

• 1 skein DN110-14 Terracotta Heather (B)

1 skein DN110-02 Golden Heather (C)

**Needles:** Size US 8 (5mm) circular needle 32" (80cm) long *or size needed to obtain gauge* **Notions:** Stitch marker, tapestry needle

Gauge: 18 sts and 36 rounds = 4" (10cm) in Slip

Stitch Pattern Stitch Guide:

**Slip Stitch Pattern** (multiple of 4 sts)

**Rnd 1:** With B, \* P3, sl 1 wyib; rep from \* to

end.

**Rnd 2:** With B, \* k1, p1, k1, sl 1 wyib; rep from

\* to end.

Rnd 3: With A, \* p1, sl 1 wyif, p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

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Rnd 4: With A, \* k1, sl 1 wyif, k2; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 5:** With C, \* p3, sl 1 wyib; rep from \* to end.

**Rnd 6:** With C, \* k1, p1, k1, sl 1 wyib; rep from \* to end.

Rnd 7: With A, rep Rnd 3. Rnd 8: With A, rep Rnd 4.

Rep Rnds 1-8 for pattern.

## **Project Notes:**

This stitch pattern has the interesting effect of producing a fabric that is very different on the two sides. One side shows primarily color A, the other side shows primarily colors B and C. Both sides look great!

To make the piece longer or shorter, increase or decrease the number of sts cast on in multiples of 4.

### COWL

With color A, CO 152 sts. Place marker for beginning of rnd and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist.

Rnd 1: Purl.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnds 3 and 4: Rep Rnds 1 and 2.

Change to color B and begin working Slip Stitch

Pattern.

Work Rnds 1-8 of Slip Stitch pattern seven times, then work Rnds 1-6 once more.

Change to color A.

**Next Rnd:** \* P3, sl 1 wyib; rep from \* to end.

**Next Rnd:** Knit. **Next Rnd:** Purl.

Rep last 2 rnds once more.

# Finishing:

Weave in ends and block lightly.
