

Wall Hanging

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 16"

Length: 20" measured from top of dowel to point, excluding tassel

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *D.I.Y. Gradient Yarn* (100% Antipilling Acrylic; 200g/360 yds)

• #1046-05 Brown – 1 set

Notions: Sharp scissors or rotary cutter, quilting ruler, cutting mat, 36" long ½" wooden dowel, wood beads in various sizes, tassel maker, small tapestry needle

STITCH GUIDE

Lark's Head Knot

Fold one strand of yarn in half, forming a loop. Place loop end under dowel. Bringing cut ends over top of dowel, thread cut ends through loop. Pull firmly to secure around dowel.

WALL HANGING

Cut 20 – 48" lengths of each color. *Working across dowel from lightest to darkest shade, tie Lark's Head Knot with 10 lengths of each color to middle. Rep from * working from darkest shade to lightest. Using scissors or rotary cutter, quilt ruler and cutting mat, cut loose ends at an angle to form center point so that point is 20" long from top of dowel to point, referencing photo as a guide.

Tassels

Using instructions provided by manufacturer, make 2 - 5'' tassels in lightest shade and 1 - 5'' tassel in darkest shade.

FINISHING

Light Tassels

Cut 2 - 48" lengths of yarn in lightest shade. Using tapestry needle, thread length of yarn through top of tassel. Thread both cut ends through eye of tapestry needle and thread desired number of beads onto strand. Secure beads with a knot. Trim excess so that there is a 10" length of yarn from top of tassel for lightest shade. Tie knot 2" from end of strand. Thread 1 small bead onto strand. Tie second knot to secure. Using Lark's Head Knot, attach tassel to dowel using photo as a guide. Repeat for second tassel.

Dark Tassel

Cut 1 - 48" length of yarn in darkest shade. Work as for light tassel, trimming excess to 24".

Cut additional strand of yarn to desired length for hanging. Tie ends at each end of dowel between loose strands and tassels.
