



# Woven Plaid Throw

Level: Intermediate

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

44" x 55"

## MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Everyday® Soft Worsted** (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 113gm/203 yds)

- 100-07 Really Red (A) – 4 balls
- 100-44 Christmas Green (C) – 4 balls
- 100-01 Snow White (D) – 2 balls

**Premier® Yarns Everyday® Soft Worsted Heather** (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 100gm/180 yds)

- 110-01 Red Heather (B) – 4 balls

**Hook:** US Size J/10 (6 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

17 sts x 8 rows = 4" in hdc, ch 1 mesh, before weaving

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## PATTERN NOTES

Blanket will be closer to 52" long before beginning weaving. The process of weaving will draw in the fabric some losing a little length, keeping weaving relaxed will help minimize length lost.

## THROW

With A, ch 223 sts.

**Row 1:** Hdc in 5<sup>th</sup> ch from hook (skipped chains count as hdc, ch 1), [ch 1, sk 1 ch, hdc in next ch] across, turn – 220 ch-1 sps.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as hdc, ch 1), (ch 1, hdc in next hdc) across, ending with last hdc in second ch of beginning ch-3, turn – 220 ch-1 sps.

Rep Row 2; working 2 more rows in A, 4 rows in B, 2 rows in C, 2 rows in D, 2 rows in B, 4 rows in A, 2 rows in B, 6 rows in C, 2 rows in D, 4 rows in B, 2 rows in A, 2 rows in B, 4 rows in D, 2 rows in C, 4 rows in A, 2 rows in B, 6 rows in C, 2 rows in D, 6 rows in C, 2 rows in B, 4 rows in A, 2 rows in C, 4 rows in D, 2 rows in B, 2 rows in A, 4 rows in B, 2 rows in D, 6 rows in C, 2 rows in B, 4 rows in A, 2 rows in B, 2 rows in D, 2 rows in C, 4 rows in B, 4 rows in A. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## Weaving

Cut 3 lengths of A, 75" long. Hold together and thread onto tapestry needle.

Starting at the bottom right corner of the blanket weave over then under up the column of ch-1 sps along the right edge, starting with going over the first horizontal bar.

Cut 3 more lengths of A.

Weave in the same fashion up the next column of ch-1 sps, starting with going under the first horizontal bar.

Center lengths of yarn in blanket so approx. 8" extends out the top and bottom of the blanket. Tie the 6 ends on the bottom in an overhand knot. Tie the 6 ends on the top in an overhand knot.

Repeat these 2 columns of weaving once more with A, twice with B, once with C, once with D, once with B, twice in A, once with B, 3 times with C, once with D, twice with B, once with A, once with B, twice with D, once with C, twice with A, once with B, 3 times with C, once with D, 3 times with C, once with B, twice with A, once with C, twice with D, once with B, once with A, twice with B, once with D, 3 times with C, once with B, twice with A, once with B, once with D, once with C, twice with B, and twice with A.

Trim ends of fringe to 6".
