

# Woven Trivet

By Premier Yarns Design Team Level: Intermediate



#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

11" square

#### **MATERIALS**

**Premier®** *Home™ Cotton Multi* (85% Cotton, 15% Polyester; 60gm/105 yds)

• #44-33 Woodland (A) – 1 balls **Premier**<sup>®</sup> *Home*<sup>™</sup> *Cotton* (85% Cotton, 15%

Polyester; 80gm/140 yds)

#38-02 Cream (B) – 1 ball

• #35-15 Sage (C) – 1 ball

Hook: US Size H-8 (5 mm) crochet hook or size

needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle

#### **GAUGE**

12 dc x 7 rows = 4"

Save time, check your gauge.

# **TRIVET**

Square (make 1)

With A, loosely ch 53.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 2 chs, \* 2 sc in next ch, sc in next 12 chs; rep from \* 2 more times, 2 sc in next ch, sc in next 9 chs - 56 scs.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), sk first st, dc in next 8 sts, \* 2 dc in each of the next 2 sts, dc in next 12 sts; rep from \* 2 more times, 2 dc in each of the next 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts - 64 dcs.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, sk first st, dc in next 3 sts, \* 2 dc in each of the next 2 sts, dc in next 14 sts; rep from \* 2 more times, 2 dc in each of the next 2 sts, dc in next 10 sts -72 dcs.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, sk first st, dc in next 10 sts, \* 2 dc in each of the next 2 sts, dc in next 16 sts; rep from \* 2 more times, 2 dc in each of the next 2 sts, dc in next 5 sts - 80 dcs.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in first dc and next 4 sts, \* 2 sc in next 4 sts, sc in next 16 sts; rep from \* 2 more times, 2 sc in next 4 sts, sc in next 11 sts.

Fasten off.

Sew the two ends together to form a square.

Ovals (make 1 with color B and 1 with color C)

Leaving a long tail, ch 63.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 4 chs, 3 sc in next ch, sc in next 30 chs, 3 sc next ch, 1 sc next 25 chs - 66 scs.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), sk first st, dc in the next 24 sts, 2 dc next st, 3 dc next st, 2 dc next st, dc in next 30 sts; 2 dc next st, 3 dc next st, 2 dc next st, dc in the next 5 sts - 74 dcs.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, sk first st, dc in the next 5 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 st, 3 dc next st, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, dc in the next 32 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 st, 3 dc next st, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, dc in the next 26 sts - 86 dcs.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in next 27 sts, 2 sc in each of next 9 sts, 1 sc in next 34 sts, 2 sc in each of next 9 sts, sc in next 7 sts. 104 scs.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

## **FINISHING**

Begin with the Square laid flat on a table.

Weave the first Oval through the Square as shown, then sew the ends together.

Weave the second Oval though the Square and the first Oval as shown, then sew the ends together. For additional stability, sew the layers together along the lines where they overlap. Weave in ends.
