

# Gradient Waves Cowl

By Premier Yarns Design Team Level: Intermediate



#### **SIZES**

One Size

#### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Width: 14½" Length: 38"

#### **MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns *Aurora* (100% Acrylic; 100g/166 yds)

#1028-02 Current (A) – 1 ball
 #1028-08 Midnight (B) – 1 ball

Needle: US Size 10 (6 mm) straight needles or size

needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle

#### **GAUGE**

15 sts x 30 rows = 4" in Garter St Save time, check your gauge.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

Cowl is worked as a long strip, and then the ends are sewn together. To avoid having a lot of ends to weave in when finishing, carry the color not in use loosely along the side of Cowl until it is needed again.

#### **COWL**

With A, cast on 61 sts.

Row 1 (RS): With A, K1, m1, k8, \* s2kp, k8, m1, k1, m1, k8; rep from \* once more, s2kp, k8, m1, k1.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: Change to B, rep Row 1.

Row 4: Knit.

Repeat Rows 1-4 until piece measures 38", ending with Row 1 in color B.

Bind off.

### **FINISHING**

Sew bound off edge to cast on edge, being careful not to twist. Weave in ends. Block gently.

## **Abbreviations**

k knit

m1 insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked

and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)

**RS** Right Side

s2kp slip 2 stitches together, knit 1, pass two slip stitches over – 2 sts dec'd

st(s) stitch(es)
