## Carlyle Cabled Scarf

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS
Length: 60"
Width: $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
MATERIALS
Isaac Mizrahi ${ }^{\oplus}$ CRAFT ${ }^{\text {Tm }}$ Carlyle by Premier ${ }^{\circledR}$ Yarns (77\% acrylic, 15\% metallic, 8\% polyamide; $70 \mathrm{~g} / 127 \mathrm{yds}$ )

- IM2008-05 Plaza-4 balls

Hook: US Size $\mathrm{N}(9 \mathrm{~mm})$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
Notions: Tapestry needle, large pom pom maker
GAUGE
9 sc x 10 rows: 4"
Save time, check your gauge.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

FPDC (Front Post Double Crochet): Working on the RS of work, yarn over, insert hook around post of indicated dc (from front to back to front), yarn over, pull through, [yarn over, pull through 2 lps on hook] twice.
BPDC (Back Post Double Crochet): Working on the WS of work, yarn over, inset hook around post of indicated dc (from back to front to back), yarn over, pull through, [yarn over, pull through 2 lps on hook] twice.
1/2 LC ( $\mathbf{1}$ over $\mathbf{2}$ Left Cross Cable): Skip 1 dc , FPDC around each of next 2 dc , working over the top of FPDC just made, FPDC around skipped dc.
1/2 RC (1 over 2 Right Cross Cable): Skip 2 dc, FPDC around next dc, working underneath FPDC just made, FPDC around each of 2 skipped dc.
$\mathbf{2 / 2}$ LC (2 over $\mathbf{2}$ Left Cross Cable): Skip 2 dc , FPDC around each of next 2 dc , working over the top of FPDC just made, FPDC around each of 2 skipped dc.
2/2 RC (2 over $\mathbf{2}$ Right Cross Cable): Skip 2 dc , FPDC around each of next 2 dc , working underneath FPDC just made, FPDC around each of 2 skipped dc.

## PROJECT TIP

Be sure to work all double crochet stitches around the post!

## SCARF

Ch 23.
Set-up row 1 (RS): Sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from hook and each ch across, turn - 22 sc .
Set-up row 2 (WS): Ch 1 , sc in next 3 sc , dc in next 3 sc , sc in next 2 sc , dc in next 6 dc , sc in next 2 sc , dc in next 3 sc , sc in last 3 sc , turn.

## Beg Patt

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1 , sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 1 / 2 \mathrm{LC}$, sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 / 2 \mathrm{LC}$, FPDC around the next 2 dc , sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 / 2 \mathrm{RC}$, sc in next 3 sc , turn.
Row 2: Ch 1, sc in next 3 sc, BPDC around the next 3 FPDC, sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{BPDC}$ around the next 6 FPDC, sc in next 2 $s c$, BPDC around the next 3 FPDC, sc in next 3 sc , turn.
Row 3: Ch 1 , $s c$ in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 1 / 2 \mathrm{LC}$, $s c$ in next 2 sc , FPDC around the next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 / 2 \mathrm{RC}$, $s c$ in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 1 / 2 \mathrm{RC}$, $s c$ in next 3 sc , turn.
Row 4: Rep row 2.
Rep rows 1-4 until piece measures 60", ending after Row 2 or 4 of patt.
Next row: Ch 1, sc in each sc and dc across. Fasten off. Make 4-11/2" pom poms and affix to each corner.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends and block lightly
