



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 34 (38, 42, 46, 50)"

Length: 22 (22½, 23½, 24, 25)"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Cotton Fair (52% cotton, 48% acrylic; 100g/317 yds)

- 27-04 Turquoise – 3 (3, 4, 4, 5) balls

Needles: US Size 5 (3.75 mm) straight needles **or** size to obtain gauge

Notions: Stitch markers, tapestry needle

GAUGE

22 sts x 32 rows = 4" in Garter St

Save time, check your gauge.

Directions:

STITCH GUIDE

Agave Stitch (multiple of 19 sts)

Row 1 (RS): P5, k4, yo, k3, ssk, p5.

Row 2 (WS): K5, p9, k5.

Row 3: P4, k2tog, k3, yo, k1, to, k3, ssk, p4.

Row 4: K4, p11, k4.

Row 5: P3, k2tog, [k3, yo] twice, k3, ssk, p3.

Row 6: K3, p13, k3.

Row 7: P2, k2tog, k3, yo, k5, yo, k3, ssk, p2.

Row 8: K2, p15, k2.

Row 9: P1, k2tog, k3, yo, k7, yo, k3, ssk, p1.

Row 10: K1, p17, k1.

Rep Rows 1-10 for patt.

TANK

Front

Cast on 112 (125, 135, 148, 160) sts.

Row 1: K18 (23, 28, 33, 39), pm, k38 (41, 41, 44, 44), pm, k19 (19, 19, 19, 19) sts, pm, knit to end of row.

Establish Pattern: Work garter st to first marker, Agave Stitch to next M, garter to next M, Agave to next M, Garter to end of row.

Work as established until Front measures 14 (14½, 15½, 16, 17)" from cast-on edge.

Shape Neck

Next Row (RS): Work in patt to 2nd marker, k9 (10, 10, 11, 11), bind off 20 (21, 21, 22, 22) sts, work in patt to end of row. Remainder of Fronts will be worked separately.

Left Front

Next row and all WS rows: Work in patt as established.

Dec Row (RS): K2tog, work to end of row as established.

Rep last 2 rows 8 (9, 9, 10, 10) more times.

Continue working evenly until Front measures 7 (7½, 8, 8½, 9)" from beginning of Neck Shaping. Bind off all sts.

Right front

Attach yarn at neck edge.

Next row and all WS rows: Work in patt as established.

Dec Row (RS): Work to last 2 sts as established, ssk.

Rep last 2 rows 8 (9, 9, 10, 10) more times.

Continue working evenly until Front measures 7 (7½, 8, 8½, 9)" from beginning of Neck Shaping. Bind off all sts.

Back

Work as for Front.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew side seams leaving 7 (7½, 8, 8½, 9)" open for armholes. Weave in all ends. Block gently.

Abbreviations

dec decrease

k knit

k2tog knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)

m marker

maint maintaining

meas measures

ndl(s) needle(s)

p purl

patt pattern

pm place marker
rep repeat(ing)
RS right side
ssk slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
st(s) stitch(es)
WS wrong side
yo yarn over
