

Daisy Patch Sweater

Level: Intermediate



SIZES

Small (Medium, Large)

Shown in Small Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust: 40 (48, 56)''

Length: 24 (24, 28)''

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Cotton Fair (52% cotton, 48% acrylic; 100gm/317 yds)

- #32-05 Sunshine Day (A) – 2 (2, 3) balls
- #27-10 Leaf Green (B) – 2 (2, 3) balls

Hook: US Size E-4 (3.5 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

Motif = 4'' x 4''

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Beginning Cluster (Beg-CL): Ch 2, yo twice, insert hk in sp and pull up a lp, yo and draw through 2 lps on hk, yo and insert hk in same sp and pull up a lp, yo and draw through 2 lps on hk, yo and draw through all lps on hk.

Cluster (CL): [Yo, insert hk in st and pull up a lp, yo and draw through 2 lps on hk] 3 times in same st, yo and draw through all lps on hk.

Daisy Motif

With A, ch 6, sl st in 1st ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), [dc in ring, ch 1] 11 times, sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 to join – 12 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 2: Sl st in next ch-1 sp, work Beg-CL in same sp, ch 3, [CL in next ch-1 sp, ch 3] 11 times, sl st in top of Beg-CL to join. Fasten off. Cut A.

Rnd 3: Join B in any ch-3 sp, ch 1, sc in same sp, ch 5, [sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 5] 10 times, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 2, dc in 1st sc to join – 12 ch-5 sps.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in same sp, ch 5, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 1, (5 dc, ch 3, 5 dc, ch 1) in next ch-5 sp, * sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 5, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 1, (5 dc, ch 3, 5 dc, ch 1) in next ch-5 sp; rep from * 2 more times, sl st in 1st sc to join – 4 ch-3 corner sps.
Fasten off.

Join as you go: On Rnd 4, work the following on sides to be joined, starting with the corner ch-3, work 3rd ch for corner as sl st in adjacent ch-3 sp, 5 dc in same ch-5 sp, ch 1, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 2, sl st in adjacent ch-5 sp, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 1, 5 dc in ch-5 sp, sl st in adjacent ch-3 sp, ch 1 or 2 (ch 1 if next side is to be joined).

SWEATER

Make 72 (82, 110) Daisy Motifs, joining as you go according to the Assembly Diagram for your size. Front and Backs are identical. There is one motif running along the side up to the under arms, when you reach the underarms, this line of Motifs turn and continue to form the bottom edge of the sleeve (there will be a spot at either side of the underarm where 5 motifs all join the corner, instead of 4, forming a 3-dimensional “T” shape).

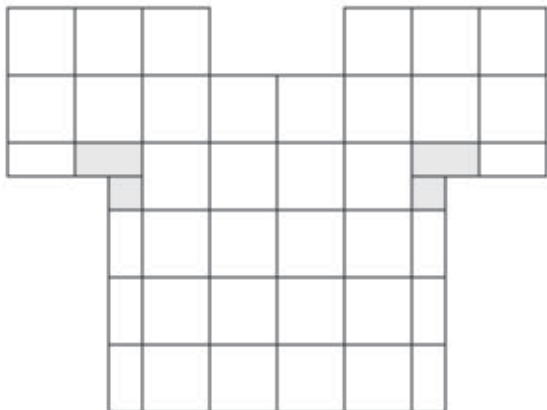
FINISHING

Work 1 rnd of single crochet along hem, sleeve openings, and neck opening.
Weave in ends.

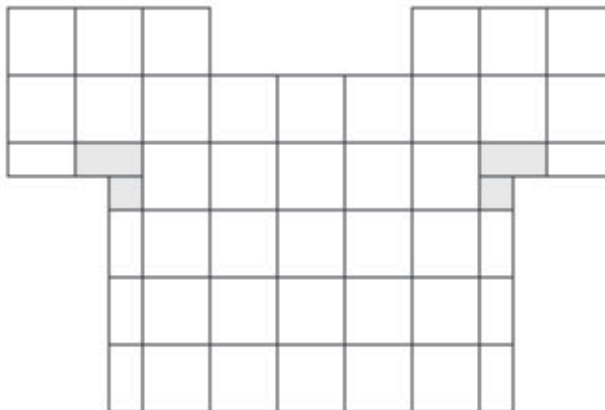
Abbreviations

sl st	slip stitch
sp	space

yo	yarn over

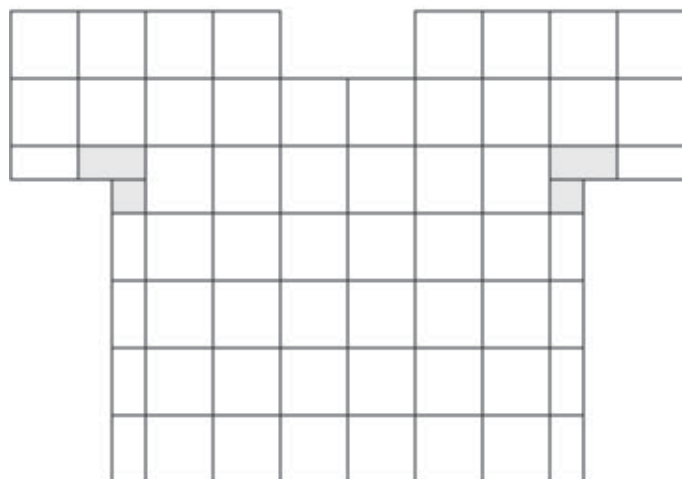
Small (40" Bust) = 72 Motifs

Large (56" Bust) = 110 Motifs
