



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 15"

Width: 30"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Cotton Fair (52% cotton, 48% acrylic; 100gm/317 yds)

- #27-07 Bright Peach (A) – 1 ball
- #32-10 Campfire (B) – 2 balls

Hook: US Size G-6 (4 mm) hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

GAUGE

18 dcs x 11 Rows = 4"

Motif: 15 x 15 x 15"

Save time, check your gauge.

Directions:

STRIPE SEQUENCE PATTERN

Rnd 1-3: A

Rnd 4-6: B

Rnd 7: A

Rnd 8: B

Rnd 9-10: A

Rnd 11-13: B

Rnd 14: A

STITCH GUIDE

Shell (Sh): 3 dc, ch 4, 3 dc

SHAWLETTE

Triangle Motif (Make 5)

Rnd 1: With A, ch 4, join with sl st to 1st ch to form a ring.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc now and throughout), 2 dc, ch 4, *3 dc, ch 4; rep from * once more. Join with sl st to top of beg ch-3 – 3 ch-4 sp.

Rnd 3: Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, shell in next ch-4 sp, *dc in next 3 dc, shell in ch-4 sp; rep once more – 9 dc bet each ch-4 sp.

Rnd 4: Change to B, ch 3, dc in each dc to ch-4 sp, sh in ch-4 sp, *dc in each dc bef ch-4 sp, sh in ch-4 sp; repeat once more. Dc in each dc to beg ch 3, join with sl st to top of beg ch 3.

Rnds 5 – 14: Following Stripe Sequence Pattern, rep Rnd 4. Finished round will have 75 dc on each triangle side and 3 ch-4 sp.

FINISHING

Using assembly diagram as a guide, sew or crochet triangle sides together. Weave in ends.
