



## SIZES

Women's Extra Small (Small, Medium, Large, Extra Large, 2X)

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**To Fit Bust Size:** 36 (40, 44, 48, 52, 56)" (oversized fit)

**Length:** 22 (22, 23, 23, 24, 24)"

## MATERIALS

**Premier Yarns Deborah Norville Cotton Soft Silk**  
(78% cotton, 22% silk; 85gm/154 yds)

- #950-09 Navy Blue – 4 (4, 5, 6, 7, 8) balls (A)
- #950-04 Fuchsia Flower – 1 (1, 1, 1, 2, 2) balls (B)
- #950-02 Tangerine – 1 (1, 1, 1, 2, 2) balls (C)

## Needles:

US Size 8 (5 mm) 24" circular needles *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers

## GAUGE

18 sts x 24 rows = 4" in St st

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## STITCH GUIDE

**St st - Stockinette stitch:** Knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows.

## Stripe Pattern

**Rows 1 (RS) - 6:** With A, work in St st.

**Rows 7-8:** With B, work in St st.

**Rows 9-14:** With A, work in St st.

**Rows 15-16:** With C, work in St st.

Rep Rows 1-16 for patt.

## BACK

With A, cast on 82 (90, 100, 108, 118, 126) sts. Work in garter st (knit every row) for  $\frac{3}{4}$ ". Work in stripe patt until piece meas 22 (22, 23, 23, 24, 24)" from beg, ending with a WS row.

**Next row (RS):** K18 (22, 25, 29, 32, 36) sts, join a second ball of yarn and bind off center 46 (46, 50, 50, 54, 54) sts, knit to end. Working both sides separately at the same time, work next WS row, then bind off.

## FRONT

Work as for Back.

Sew shoulder seams.

## SLEEVES

Measure down 6 (6, 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ , 7, 7  $\frac{1}{2}$ , 8)" from shoulder seam on each side, place marker on front and back. With RS facing and A, pick up and knit 54 (54, 58, 64, 68, 72) sts between markers for sleeve. Work in stripe patt until sleeve meas 5  $\frac{1}{4}$  (5  $\frac{1}{4}$ , 5  $\frac{3}{4}$ , 5  $\frac{3}{4}$ , 6  $\frac{1}{4}$ , 6  $\frac{1}{4}$ )". With A, work in garter st for  $\frac{3}{4}$ ". Bind off loosely.

## FINISHING

Sew side and sleeve seams.

## Neck Trim

With RS facing and A, pick up and knit 92 (92, 100, 100, 108, 108) sts around neck opening. Do not join. Work in garter st for  $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Bind off loosely. Sew edges of trim tog.

Weave in ends. Block.
